Just a reminder that one of LUHSDs criteria for students to Reclassify is the student's performance on a ELA District Common Assessment or their ELA SBAC. Here is our districts Reclassification criteria:

- Score of Level 4 on Summative ELPAC
- C- or better in English
- 2.0 + GPA
- Score of Proficient on DCA/Standard Nearly Met on ELA SBAC
- Parent Approval

We do have several students that scored a Level 4 on the ELPAC from last spring, but did not have one or more of the other criteria they needed to earn their Reclassification in their second semester. We can still use their score and the criteria from the first semester of this school year. If you have a student that could still earn their reclassification I will be reaching out to give you a heads up.

You will receive emails from students' case managers to notify you about each student's IEP at a glance and any additional information needed to support the student.

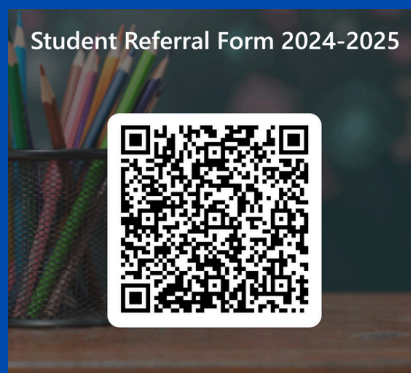

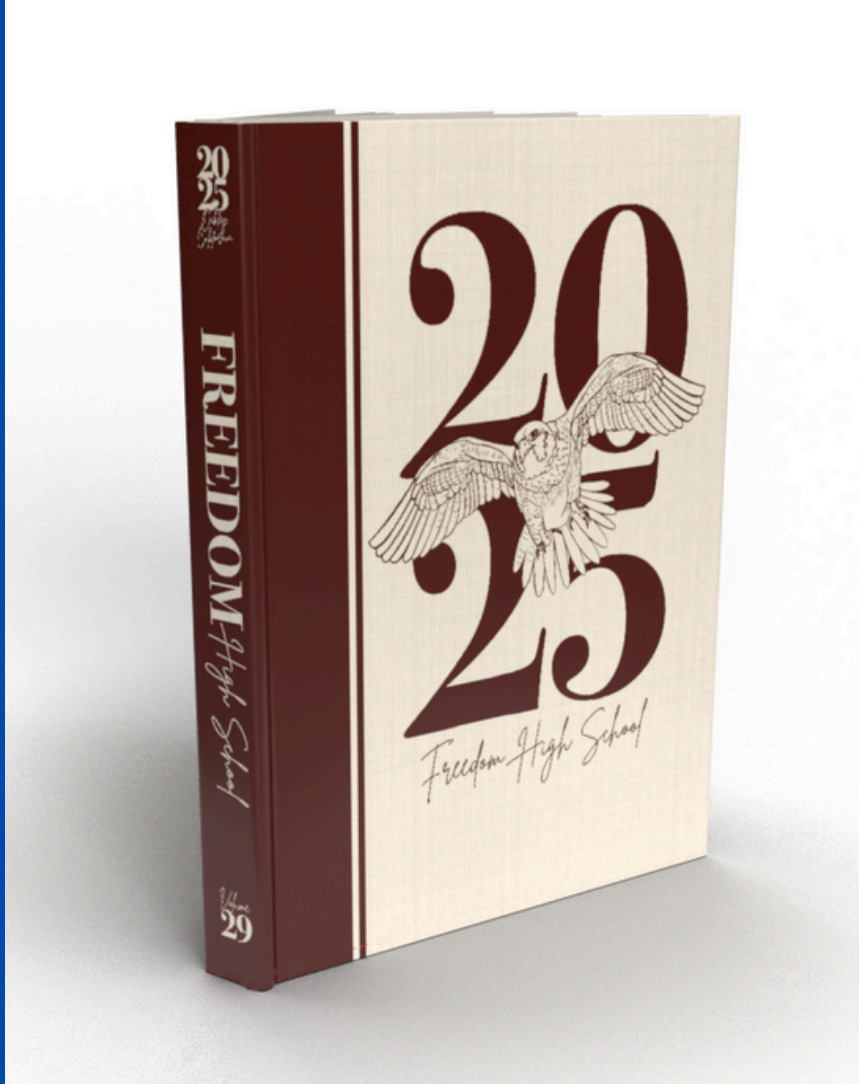

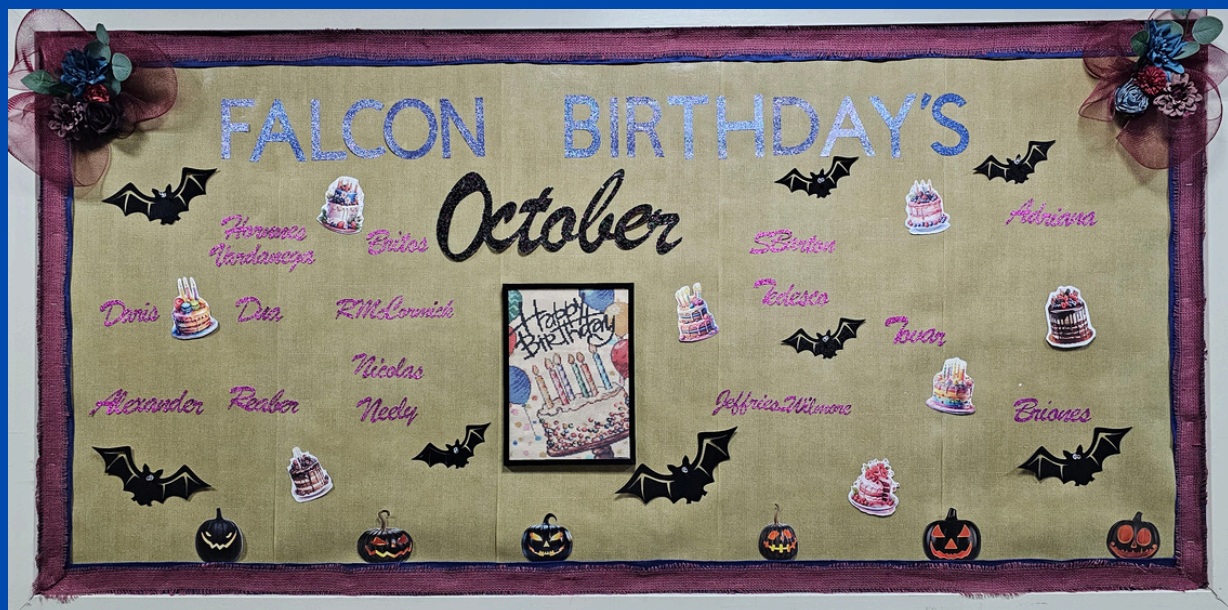

Purchasing Cutoff Dates Fiscal Year 2024-2025

In order to assure that items purchased are received in advance of the end of the year, it is necessary to have a purchasing cutoff that allows ample time for deliveries. The District's purchasing cut off dates for Fiscal Year 2024/2025 are outlined below:

- **Sat, March 1, 2025....All Requisitions for Computers and Furniture**
- **Tues, April 15, 2025....All other requisitions (State or Out of State)**
- **Wed, April 30, 2025....Southwest or Office Depot internet orders or other local vendors (in Contra Costa County). All backorders will be cancelled on June 2, 2023.**
 - **All PO increases must be submitted.**
- **Fri, May 30, 2025 All Reimbursements turned into your site principal.**

Please plan your purchases in anticipation of these deadlines. All items must be received not later than June 30, 2025. If items are not received by June 30th, your order will be cancelled.

The exception to the above deadlines are: facilities projects, custodial supplies, travel and conference incurred after these deadlines, and summer school.
