At no cost to you as a district employee/student, you now have access to:

- **5 Licenses to Microsoft Office Suite** downloadable to any personal device (i.e. tablet, cell, home comp.) that auto-upgrades as new versions of Office are released.
- 1 TB of storage information is now accessible from any device that can access the internet
- Collaborative file sharing, convenient access to docs, and other cloud-based (Google, DropBox, etc.) functions that systems offer.
