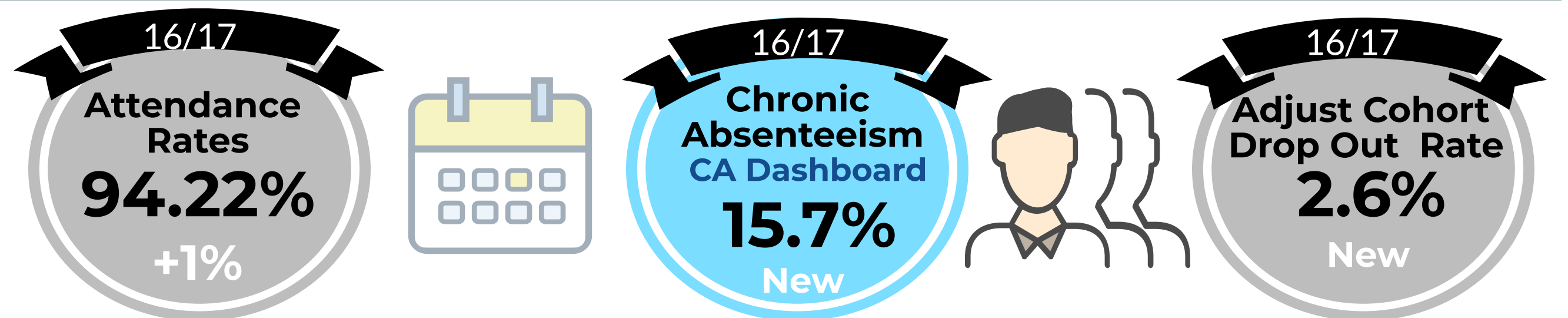
GOAL 1:

The Liberty Union High School District (LUHSD) will provide a physically and emotionally supportive school environment which supports student learning by:

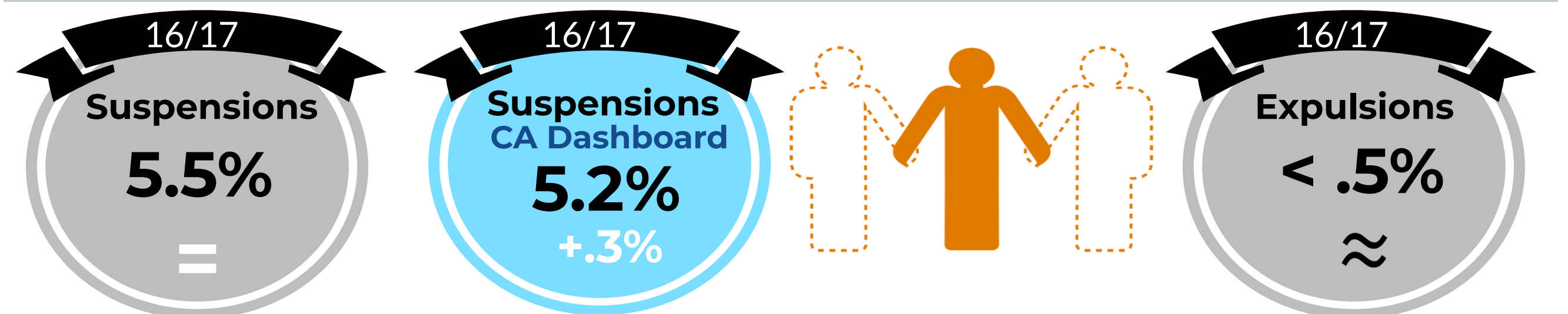
- Providing a safe, secure, updated, clean environment.

- Aligning operating budget to the LUHSD Strategic Plan and the goals outlined in the LCAP.



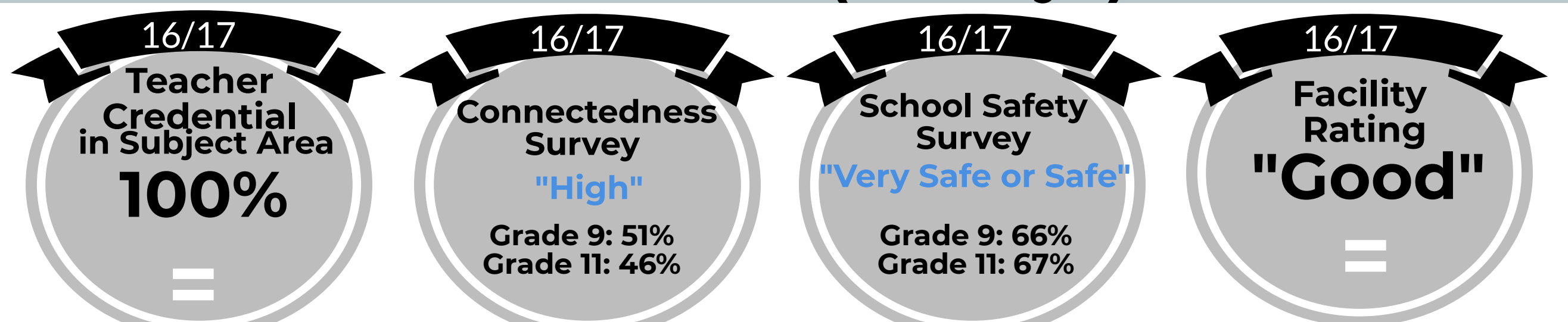

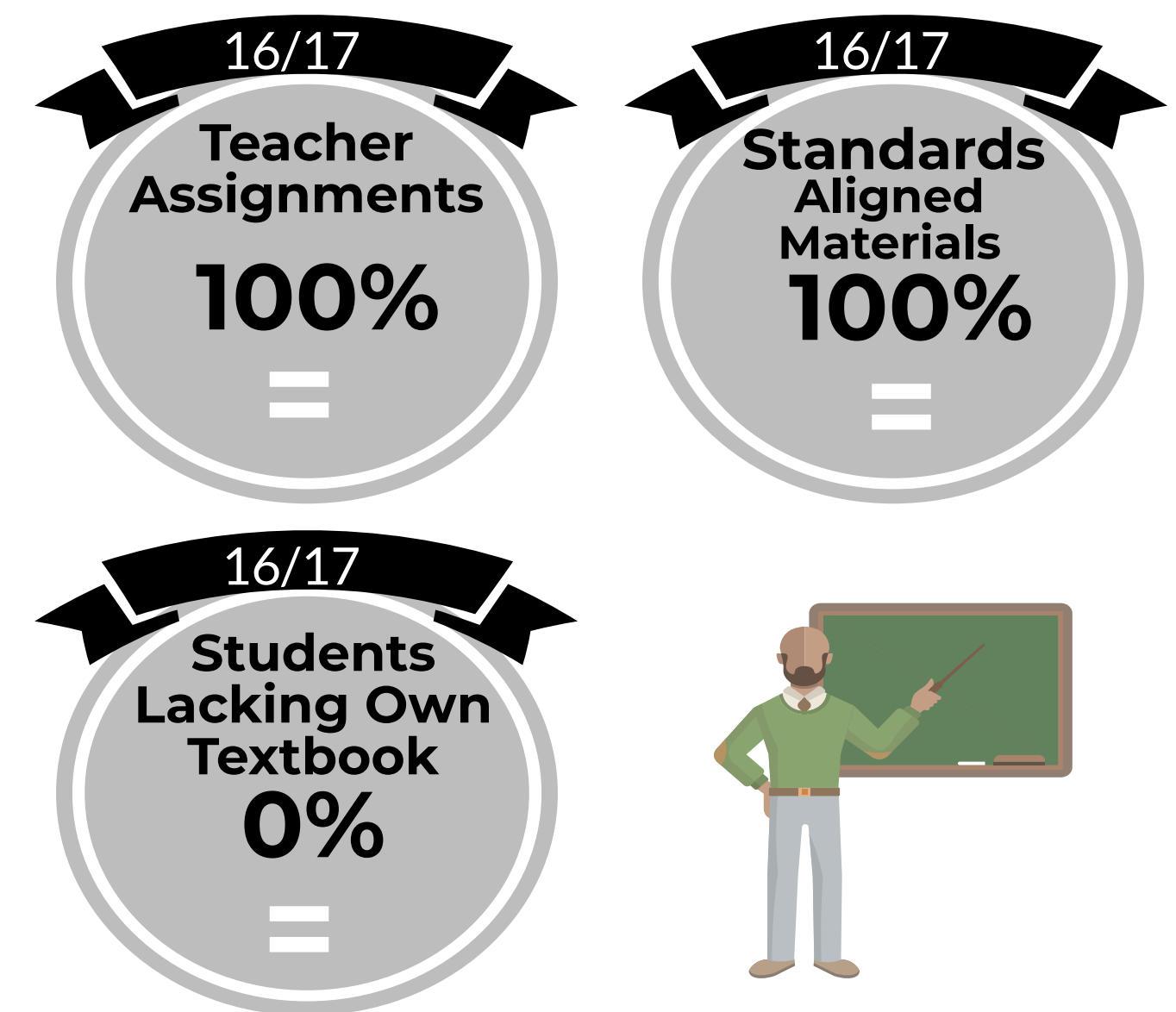
GOAL 2:

- Providing relevant curriculum, and instruction to expand, enrich, and support career opportunities.



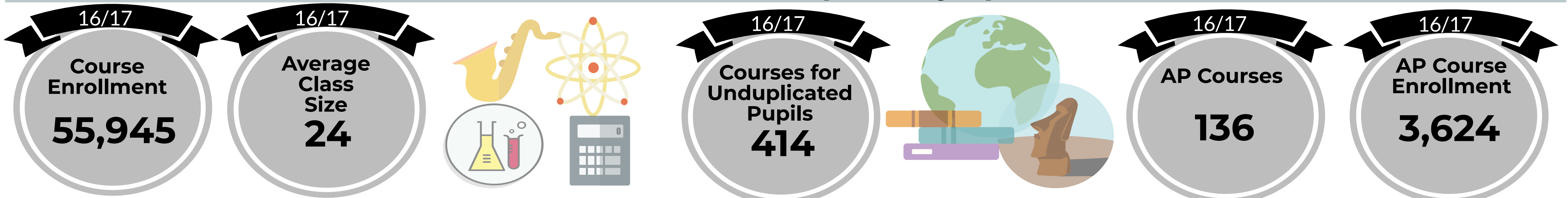
