<p>TRUE OR FALSE</p> <p>Write 10 statements about the story <i>in English</i>. Five of the statements must be true, and five must be false. Be sure to mark which answer is correct!</p>	<p>MY PERSPECTIVE</p> <p>Rewrite the story <i>in German</i> from your own perspective: as if YOU were the main character in the story and you were telling the story about yourself.</p> <p>(So, for example, instead of “Kaspar isst Suppe,” “<u>Ich</u> esse Suppe.”)</p>	<p>DICTIONARY</p> <p>Pick 10 new words that you learned.</p> <p>For each word...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Draw a picture of it. 2. Label the picture. 3. Write 1 sentence, <i>in German</i>, that uses the word.
<p>IT’S A LIE!</p> <p>Write a new version of the story (<i>in German</i>). Change every detail so that every single thing in the new story is a “lie” about the old one. (Hint: Think about negating things with the words “kein” or “nicht”:</p> <p>zB: Es gibt Suppe. → Es gibt <u>keine</u> Suppe.</p> <p>zB: Ich liebe dich. → Ich liebe dich <u>nicht</u>.)</p>	<p>EXPANSION</p> <p>Expand the story by adding one new sentence in between each existing sentence. All writing should be done <i>in German</i>.</p>	<p>CLOSE READING</p> <p><i>In German</i>, write down which sentence of the story you think...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. is the most important sentence. 2. is the most surprising sentence. 3. is your favorite sentence. 4. is the most confusing sentence. 5. is the least interesting sentence. <p>Then, <i>in English</i>, explain WHY you made each of your choices.</p>
<p>SHRINKING SUMMARIES</p> <p>Write a five-sentence summary of the story <i>in German</i>. Then, write a two-sentence summary of your summary, also <i>in German</i>.</p>	<p>JEOPARDY</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Copy over 5 sentences from the story <i>in German</i>. 2. Write a question, <i>in German</i>, that would produce each of the sentences as its answer. <p>(5 questions total)</p>	<p>IT ALL ADDS UP</p> <p>Write a longer version of the story, <i>in German</i>, by adding at least two words to each sentence.</p>
