IT'S A LIE!

Write a new version of the story (in German). Change **every** detail so that every single thing in the new story is a "lie" about the old one. (Hint: Think about negating things with the words "kein" or "nicht":

zB: Es gibt Suppe. → Es gibt <u>keine</u> Suppe.

zB: Ich liebe dich. → Ich liebe dich nicht.)

EXPANSION

Expand the story by adding one new sentence in between each existing sentence. All writing should be done in German.

CLOSE READING

In German, write down which sentence of the story you think...
