The Three Modes of Communication:

• Interpersonal Communication: Learners interact and negotiate meaning in spoken or written conversations to share information, reactions, feelings, and opinions.

• Interpretive Communication: Learners understand, interpret, and analyze what is heard, read, or viewed on a variety of topics.

• **Presentational Communication:** Learners present information, concepts, and ideas to inform, explain, persuade, and narrate on a variety of topics using appropriate media and adapting to various audiences of listeners, readers, or viewers.
