Policy for Students With Special Dietary Needs

1. Students With Disabilities:

- a. Students with disabilities must provide a written statement from a licensed physician and complete form CNP-925.
- b. All approvals must be reviewed by the Food Service Supervisor and filed for at least three years.
- c. If it is determined that a student has a disability, the Food Service Director will add the disability onto the Nutrikids Software so that the student can be provided with a replacement meal.
- d. All students with disabilities will be provided with replacement meals.

2. Students with "Non-Disabilities":

- a. Students that do not have a disability but request meal accommodation will need either (1) written doctor's note or (2) parental note explaining the non-disability and including possible replacement items.
- b. Accommodations will be reviewed on a case by case basis, and every attempt will be made to accommodate the student.
