

- 3. You may receive **discounted utilities** and **internet** access
- 4. You may become eligible for **free enrollment** in some afterschool care programs
- 5. You may become eligible for **Testing fee** waivers (SAT, PSAT and AP)
- 6. You may receive benefits **regardless of citizenship status**
