- 1. **Graduation Ceremony** will be in-person, with a live broadcast, on Saturday, June 5, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. at the FHS Stadium. Seniors will receive an email with a survey to indicate if attending inperson Graduation!
- 2. **Tickets** to be determined according to County Guidelines.
- 3. Class Speaker A staff committee selects a graduating senior to be the graduation speaker. Auditions will be on Tuesday, April 20 from 2:00-4:00pm. The speaker will be announced the week after auditions. Speech should be no longer than 2-3 minutes.
- 4. **Graduation Day Pictures** A professional photographer will take pictures of each graduate as he/she receives their diploma. You will be able to purchase these photographs.
