Dear Parents and Guardians,

In accordance with California law, the Liberty Union High School District requires student immunization records to be up to date and verified for students to be allowed to attend school (California Health and Safety Code 120325-120375).

Effective prior to the start of the 2019-20 school year, the California Public Health Department has made the following change to the immunization requirements:

## Requiring 2 (rather than 1) doses of chickenpox (varicella) vaccine

The above changes are required for admission or transfer to any California public school

Students **MUST** have met the following immunization requirements to be allowed to attend school:

In accordance with state law, if we do not receive evidence of your student's required immunization records, your student may be restricted from participating in walk-through registration and will not be allowed to attend any classes and/or participate in any extracurricular activities for the 2019-20 school year.

Students who are restricted from attending school because of the lack of immunization records will still be subject to compulsory education and the laws pertaining to truancy (Education Code 48293(a)).

**NOTE:** If you believe your student might meet criteria for an exemption in accordance with state law or have any further questions, please contact your student's assigned building office.
