## WEEK 7 & 8 (last assignment for the year!) DUE MAY 31! Writing Assignment (50 points)

Find an <u>epigraph</u>, which is a quote from a famous person, an excerpt from a poem, phrase, lyric, or definition that represents <u>a time or event or series of events that was</u> <u>life-altering or life-learning. (My epigraph for my signature that I use for me email is</u> <u>"Between every two pines is a doorway to a new world".)</u>

## Begin your essay with this epigraph.

Write a 650 word minimum, no maximum, on a google doc. that thoroughly describes this life-changing and/ or life-learning event(s) in your life. Write in detail of what happened in chronological order, people involved, thoughts, regrets (if any), emotions and how this event changed you for the better or for the worse. Make sure you describe the "lesson learned" at the end and some closing words of wisdom to others. Keep in mind to thread your "epigraph" throughout your essay.

Requirements:

- 1.) <u>Start with the "epigraph" of your choice and follow it's themes throughout your essay.</u>
- 2.) <u>Write cohesively -</u> follow the chain of events, sentences that make sense, <u>grammar, proof-read as</u> if your essay were to be entered into a contest for a million- dollar prize.
- 3.) <u>Use 5 forms of figurative language</u>. (metaphor, simile, personification, allusion, idiom, etc..)
- 4.) <u>Conclusion must have "words of wisdom".</u>
- 5.) Must be at least 650 words minimum -NO maximum let it flow...
- 6.) Submit to Turnitin.com under "WEEK 7&8".
