As the 2022-2023 school year approaches, a new chapter in your student's life will begin at Freedom High School.

In preparation for high school, the Freedom High School counselors will provide information about course selection and give your student a registration packet during the week of January 24 – February 1, 2022, at their middle school. If the paperwork gets misplaced, it will be available online at www.libertyunion.schoolwires.net/freedom or at your middle school office. Please note that all incoming 8th grade students must complete the enrollment process upon entering Freedom High School. All completed paperwork is due on or before Friday, February 4, 2022, to your middle school.

- Incoming 8th graders will have the opportunity to come in and verify residency during July **prior** to Walk Thru. More information with specific dates and times will be sent out toward the end of the current school year.
- If you do not complete residency verification for the 2022-2023 school year prior to Walk Thru, it must be completed at walk-thru. This includes physical documents to be photo copied at walk-thru. No visual or electronic verification will be accepted.

If you have applied for an intra-district transfer to another school in the district, you must enroll at your <u>current home school</u> until the intra-district has been approved. **Please do not fill out paperwork for both schools.** It should only be completed for the home school.

Our annual 8th Grade Parent Night will be held VIRTUALLY this Thursday, January 27th. Our English session will be from 5:00-6:00 pm and our Spanish session will be from 6:30-7:30 pm. Links will be posted on our school website and will be emailed to 8th Grade Parents. We hope you can join us. On behalf of all faculty, staff, and administrators, we welcome you and your student to Freedom High School for the 2022-2023 school year.
