- Video yourself performing selected excerpts from your Spring Concert Repertoire
- Upload your video to YouTube, and e-mail the video link to Mr. Kumagai
- The video is due by Friday, April 17 at 11:59 PM
- This first assignment is worth 50 points
- Full credit will be given based on successfully turning in a video.

Since we are all most accustomed to uploading our videos to YouTube, we will do the same this week. We *may* switch over to the SmartMusic platform in the future depending on how many pieces are in their library, and how easy the platform is to use. More information will follow in the coming weeks.

#### Guidelines for your video:

- Post each video as Public or Unlisted on YouTube to ensure your video can viewed (Private videos may not work).
- Your face and instrument must be visible in the video to ensure no digital altering of the audio has occurred.
- You may submit all excerpts in one video, or in multiple links. Send all videos in one e-mail
- Students in multiple ensembles: Please send each excerpt separately for each ensemble.

- Tenor Saxophone: Beginning to Rehearsal C
- Baritone Saxophone: Beginning to Rehearsal C
- Cornets/Trumpets: Measure 19 to Rehearsal D
- French Horns: Beginning to Rehearsal B
- Trombones: Pickup to Measure 20 to Rehearsal D
- Euphoniums: Pickup to Measure 20 to Rehearsal D
- Tubas: Beginning to Rehearsal C

- Flutes: Rehearsal E to Rehearsal F
- Oboe: Rehearsal E to Rehearsal F
- Clarinets I and II: Rehearsal E to Rehearsal F
- Clarinet III: Beginning to Rehearsal A
- Bass Clarinet: Measure 68 to Rehearsal E
- Alto Saxophones: Measure 68 to Rehearsal E
- Tenor Saxophone: Measure 68 to Rehearsal E
- Baritone Saxophone: Measure 68 to Rehearsal E
- Cornets/Trumpets: Rehearsal E to Rehearsal F
- French Horns: Rehearsal F to Rehearsal G
- Trombones: Measure 88 to Rehearsal F
- Euphoniums: Measure 84 to Rehearsal F
- Tubas: Measure 90 to Rehearsal F
