

Bethel Island Children's Support Tuition Assistance Scholarship

The Bethel Island Children's Support announces the **Bethel Island Children's Support Tuition Assistance Scholarship Awards Program.** Under the Program, scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who must be <u>full time residents on Bethel Island, Dutch Slough, Wells Rd and Sand Mound Rd.</u> The award will be for an annual Tuition amount of \$2,000 to \$10,000. The scholarship amount determination will be made by the Bethel Island Children's Support Board.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college or four (4)-year college or university.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid by **August 1 for a Fall term start**—**directly to the college**, not the student. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which includes the Student ID number, Class registration and Financial Aid Office address.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their High School Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- * Applications must be received by the Bethel Island Children's Support no later than <u>March 1st</u>. Late applications will not be accepted.
- * This is a one-year scholarship which may renewed for up to four (4) years by successfully maintaining a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale GPA, no academic or disciplinary probation, maintaining a minimum of 10 credits per fall and spring semester, providing a copy of current college transcripts at least 45 days prior to next starting term. Scholarship is transferable to a new academic institution with notification and approval.
