Freedom High School Dance Protocol

Attendance at the dance is a privilege not a right. School dances provide part of the social activities during the school year. In addition to the District Behavior Code, the following standardized policies and procedures are effective for all dances:

- You must present your current student body ID card before being allowed to purchase a ticket.
- No students will be admitted at the dance without a current FHS ID card.
- No backpacks or outside food/drinks allowed in the dance.
- Students will not be admitted to a dance more than 60 minutes after the dance starts.
- Students who leave the dance area <u>may not reenter the</u> <u>dance</u> (no parking lot access).
- A student may be asked to leave at anytime if it is determined by an administrator that their behavior is inappropriate.
- Inappropriate dancing of any kind will not be tolerated.
 Students that are dancing inappropriately will be sent to dance detention, assigned appropriate consequences, and parents will be notified.
 - Inappropriate dancing includes but is not limited to rubbing or bumping various body parts against each other, raised legs/feet, body parts other than feet being on the floor, bending over movements or any other movements considered inappropriate by an adult.
- Post Dance All students must exit the campus/premise within 30 minutes of the end of the dance.
