Hidden Figure Friday (only on Fridays)

In honor of Hispanic Heritage month, this week's hidden figure Friday is Sylvia Mendez. Unsung shero, Sylvia Mendez, paved the way for desegregation of schools in the U.S. when in third grade, she became the first Mexican-American to go to an all-white school in California. Her parents sued in the landmark case Mendez vs. Westminster in 1947, successfully desegregating all public schools in California. This was the first case in which the U.S. ruled in favor of desegregation and paved the way for the more well-known Supreme Court case, brown vs. Board of Education.
