### COLLEGE COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course prepares students to begin the culinary arts program. It is for students who do not have familiarity with kitchen knife handling and working in the kitchen. This course provides an introduction to basic skills and safety practices. (CSU)

#### D. METHODS FOR END OF COURSE ASSESSMENT:

Credit by exam: Students must receive a grade of 80% or better on the multi-choice and equipment identification exam for this course

1. Complete the Culinary and International Cuisine 1 & 2, Catering curriculum at Liberty High School, with a grade of "C" or better.

1. Apply for an account at the Contra Costa Community College System to obtain a CCCID and complete an application to DVC to obtain a seven digit DVC/Contra Costa Community College Student ID#.

2. Create a student account on CATEMA, entering all of the correct information including your CCCID and DVC Student ID# <https://www.catema.com/acsys/login.php?sdb=contracosta>
3. Complete the DVC "Credit by Exam" procedure with a grade of 80% or better.
4. Upon completion of the above, the student will receive on his/her DVC college transcript the unit credit for DVC's CULN 105.






