### **COLLEGE COURSE DESCRIPTION**

A course to develop a working knowledge of the basic principles of safety and sanitation and their application in food service operations. Effective hygiene habits and food handling practices are reinforced, for the protection of the consumers. This course must be taken before or concurrently with the first culinary lab course.

**HOURS:** 36 hrs. lecture per term

- A. SLO#1. Students completing this course will be able to identify critical control points during all food handling processes as a method for minimizing the risk of food borne illness.

- C. SLO#3. Students completing this course will be able to describe acceptable procedures when preparing foods, including time and temperature principals.
- D. SLO#4. Students completing the course will be able to recognize sanitary and safety design features of food production equipment and facilities.

  4. Complete the DVC "Credit by Exam" procedure with a grade of 80% or better.
  5. Upon completion of the above, the student will receive on his/her DVC college transcript the unit credit for DVC's CULN 153.
