O Details on event: Local Scholarship Night is a time where students who applied for local scholarships and were selected will receive their scholarship awards. o Where: Heritage Stadium or Drive-Thru Event on Site

Time: TBD

 Details on Event: Holding this event in person in our stadium requires approval; so the in person event is tentative at this point. If an in person event is not approved, we will work on holding a drive thru event for seniors. As we finalize more details, we will share them with our families.

Graduation:

o When: June 3rd

Where: Heritage StadiumTime: 7:30pm – 9pm

- Details on event: Based on the results from the survey taken by seniors and parents, there
 was an overwhelming desire to hold an in-person, more traditional graduation ceremony.
 The details below are based on our county being in the orange tier for COVID guidelines.
 If our tier or graduation guidelines change, these details may change.
 - Tickets: In accordance with state and county guidelines, we are limited to 33% capacity at outdoor seated events. This allows each graduate to receive 2 tickets.
 More details on tickets and seating will be announced as we move closer to graduation and details are finalized.
 - Ticket distribution: Seniors will be able to pick-up their 2 tickets the week before graduation. Stay tuned for additional details.
 - Practice schedule: At this time we will plan to hold rehearsals on June 2nd at 1pm and June 3rd at 8:30am. These practices are subject to change.

Site administration, staff, Class of 2021 advisors and officers are working hard to try to give our seniors as many memories as we can during this difficult year. We understand it is frustrating to not know exactly what to expect, but we appreciate your patience as we adapt to the changing guidance as it is updated and released from the state and county. As we get further details figured out about events, we will send out additional information.
