Students will meet the same core academic graduation requirements as in other schools within the District.

Requirements will establish objectives built on state guidelines for continuation schools and consideration of limited facilities and trained staff.

Course will establish objectives based on:

- 1. Objectives written for similar classes in the District.
- 2. Objectives mandated by the state for continuation schools, i.e. the provision for guidance, placement, and follow-up services regarding Work Experience.
- 3. Objectives based on the stated needs of students.

Residency Requirement:

Students must complete at least ten units in residence at La Paloma High School in order to graduate at that school. Appeals for exception to this policy may be approved by the site principal under special circumstances.

Fourth Year Limitation:

Students may earn no more than 90 units from all sources in the calendar year prior to their graduation (September-June). Appeals for exception to this policy may be approved by the site principal under special circumstances.
