


CAMPUS EVACUATION PLAN

How Does the School Prepare for an Emergency?

Heritage High School Staff is trained with a district and site approved Safety and Emergency Plan (SEP). In the beginning of the school year we schedule specific drills throughout the school year (Fire, Earthquake, Disaster, Intruder, etc.). All buildings have mandatory evacuation procedures posted with color coded arrows for each SLC and building.

How Will the Staff Respond if There is an Intruder On Campus or a Need to Lockdown the Facility?

A coded announcement will be made immediately alerting staff.

Staff will instruct students:

- 1 Duck, Cover & Hold
- 2 Secure & Cover all doors and windows
- 3 Take roll & Assess situation
- 4 Remain in secure area for further instructions

What Should a Person Do if They are Outside?

- 1 Duck, Cover & Hold
- 2 Remain still until circumstances permit you to move to the nearest room.

How Do I Know When and Where to Pick My Student Up?

If an emergency occurs where we have to evacuate the campus and parents are needed to pick up their student, HHS will communicate (ZONE 1 or 2) by using the following:

- School Computer System (contacts parents via phone, email, etc.)
- Digital Display on American Ave.
- "A" frame sign posted on Balfour Rd.
- HHS Website



The Safe Evacuation of the

SEP is designed to prepare all individuals for the impact of a major disaster or emergency affecting the school. There are 2 Safety Zones for campus evacuation. Zone 1 and 2 are designed for the safe evacuation, where parents may be required to pick up their student.

Student pick up area = (See Map)

Release of Student will ONLY occur if the student is picked up by the parent, guardian or emergency contact person noted on the student emergency card.

All Zones will have a Command Center with a staff member responsible for the safe release of
