Heritage is a state-of-the-art comprehensive high school located in Brentwood, one of the fastest growing communities in Northern California. Opened in 2005, the school is set at the urban limit line, between farmland and housing developments, reflecting the shift from an agricultural to a suburban community. Heritage currently operates under an A/B block schedule, which allows for depth as well as breadth of learning. The campus embodies the Liberty Union High School District's commitment to personalized student education through a smaller learning community model.

## STUDENTS

Heritage High School, the third comprehensive high school in the LUHSD, opened on August 1, 2005 with 717 students in ninth and tenth grades. In four short years Heritage was named a California Distinguished High School and in 2009 received a six-year accreditation from WASC.
