Subject: High School Graduation Requirements

Notifications

Requirements for graduation and specified alternative means for completing the prescribed course of study shall be made available to students, parents/guardians, and the public. (Education Code 51225.3)

(cf. 6146.2 - Certificate of Proficiency/High School Equivalency)

The senior year is defined as the 7th and 8th semester of high school. The first semester is defined as the initial enrollment in a ninth grade class (excluding summer school and concurrent enrollment as an eighth grader).

Graduating students will receive a diploma, and graduate from, the school in which the student completed the final semester.

Students will not be able to transfer to a comprehensive high school during the fourth quarter in order to graduate from the comprehensive school.

In order to receive a diploma from a comprehensive high school, a student must complete all graduation requirements within one year of the end of their 8th semester.

Principals have discretion to enroll students in a 9th and 10th semester at a high school.

In order to participate in Commencement, students must have met all graduation requirements.

High School Graduation Requirements

Requirements for graduation and specified alternative means for completing the prescribed course of study shall be made available to students, parents/guardians and the public.

Students shall not be required to have resided within the district for any minimum length of time as a condition of high school graduation.

Foreign exchange students may receive honorary diplomas pursuant to Education Code 51225.5.
