What is ASVAB?

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a standardized test that helps determine a person's strengths and aptitude for different careers. It's used by the military to help determine enlistment and job training eligibility, and is also taken by high school and post-secondary students. The ASVAB is designed to help identify careers that may be a good fit for a person, and to help them find a job that matches their strengths. A higher score on the ASVAB may make more career fields available and scores above 60 may qualify for additional bonuses and security clearance.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY! APPLY TODAY

Chevron Corporation's **Black Employee Network (BEN), San Ramon chapter** would like to cordially invite high school seniors to participate in our **2024-2025 College Scholarship Program**, which recognizes talented college-bound high school seniors. Our committee **awards seven scholarships** to deserving seniors attending schools located in the San Francisco, Alameda, and East Contra Costa County communities. The recipients are selected based on **(1) the quality of their application essay, (2) demonstrated leadership skills and/or community involvement, and (3) scholastic achievement**. Scholarship awards are in monetary increments of **\$5,000 and \$2,000**.

To be considered for this scholarship, students must complete the following steps:

1. Provide basic personal information (name, email address, phone number, etc.) using this application [2024-2025 Scholarship Application](#) (click link to open MS Forms application). The application also includes space to highlight up to 3 extracurricular and/or community service activities in which the student has participated.
2. RSVP to attend the essay writing workshop in application question #22.
3. Request their school counselor send a copy of the student's school transcript to SRBENScholarship@Chevron.com (click link to open email).
4. Select just 1 of the 5 essay topics in application Section III and write a 500-to-750 word essay. The PDF copy of their essay should be attached to an email sent to SRBENScholarship@Chevron.com (click link to open email).

We strongly recommend that interested students complete Steps #1-3 immediately and do not wait until completion of the required essay to submit their application. The application should take no longer than 15-30 minutes to complete. They can then focus most of their time on completion of the essay. We have allowed up to 5 weeks for this step.

Submission of scholarship applications, essays and transcripts are due no later than 6:00pm PST, Friday, December 6, 2024.

We are also inviting applicants to attend a MS Teams meeting on Monday evening, November 18, 2024, at 6:00pm PST, where several of our Black Employee Network members will provide coaching on how to write a strong essay. Here is the link to the MS Teams meeting. Students can simply click on or copy "Join the Meeting Now" link below into their Internet browser to connect to the meeting. Optional – Students can download the MS Teams application before the meeting, but this should not be necessary.

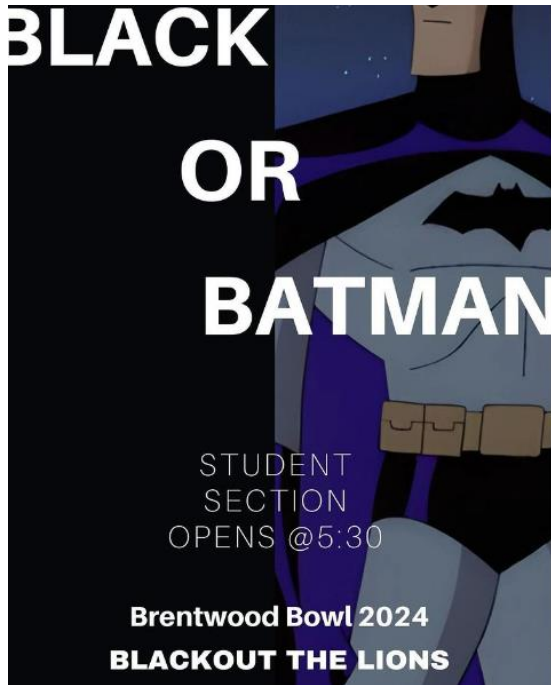
