Your child is enrolled in one or more of the following Advanced Placement (AP) Courses for the 2013/2014 school year.

AP Computer Science Computer Science

AP courses offer rigorous college-level curriculum. The National exam given at the end of the school year (May) is an integral measurement of your child's acquired knowledge in the particular subject area. Passing the AP exam with a score of 3 or higher on a 5-point scale earns college credit that your child may transfer to a university accepting AP credit. **Not all universities accept AP credit or they may require higher than a 3 for credit. Please check with your child's choice of university to review their policy.** The cost of the administration and processing of each exam is \$ 89.00.

To facilitate a smooth collection of funds and ensure accurate ordering of exams for those taking them, we request your cooperation in the following:

Return the attached "2014 AP Registration" form by Wednesday, March 12, 2014 to the HHS Student Store with the total payment for each test your student is taking (\$89 per test). For those that need a payment plan, \$45 per test is due by February 12, 2014, and the final \$44 is due by March 12, 2014.

If your child should opt not to take the AP exam prior to our ordering them, your payments will be returned. If your child orders the exam, but then chooses not to take the exam, we will retain the

\$25.00 cost for returning the exam and refund the rest of your money. We will be placing the order for exams on March 14th, 2013.

The College Board provides fee reduction for academically qualified candidates who are unable to pay the full \$89.00 fee for each AP exam. The State of California offers low-income families the opportunity to waive all but \$5.00 of the fee for the tests. **To qualify for a fee waiver you will need to provide documentation regarding family income and return attached Student Eligibility Verification form and Statement of Income Eligibility form.** It is our belief that all enrolled students should take the AP exam, and we will work with parents to facilitate the fee waiver program. In general, if you qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Lunch program, you would qualify for a fee reduction. The following is a guideline for your use.
