





Grants Require an application Do not have to be paid back Provided by government Cover different expenditures Funds are allocated to students based on financial need Grants Scholarships Require an application Do not have to be paid back Provided by private donors Allocated for specific costs Funds are allocated to student based on academic, financial, athletic, and other points









Financial Aid now takes into consideration the <u>prior-prior</u> year income. Example: the 2020-2021 FAFSA application requires income and tax information filled for 2018. Contact the Office of Financial Aid if there are circumstances for the current school year that affect the family's ability to pay for college: Loss or reduction in parent or student income or assets. Death or serious liness. Natural disasters affecting parent or student income or assets. Unusual medical or dental expenses not covered by insurance. Reduction in child support, Social Security benefits or other untaxed benefits. Any other unusual circumstances that affect a family's ability to contribute to higher education.




Disbursement Options Sign up with BankMobile for direct deposit into a personal bank account or create a bank account with BankMobile. Log in to m.4cd.edu Once logged in, tap on the "Financial Aid" file Select "My FA Disbursements" from the menu Select "BankMobile - First Time Setup" to choose your disbursement method: ▶ BankMobile Vibe Checking Account ▶ Deposit to an Existing Account



FERPA protects the privacy of educational records. • Once a student (of any age) enrolls in college their educational records cannot be released to anyone other than the student. • Students may choose to release their rights by signing a release form. • The FERPA form can be used to allow parents access to the student's educational records.

Summary of the Financial Aid Process

- ▶ Submit all required documents by the college's published deadline dates.
- ▶ Keep a copy of all paperwork submitted.
- Review the Student Aid Report (SAR) and/or the California Aid Report (CAR).
- Watch for emails from the Office of Financial Aid in the InSite Portal.

 Be sure to renew the FAFSA or Dream Act application every year as soon as possible after October 1st to receive the best Financial Aid award package possible.
