QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

To qualify for the RUA'H Community Outreach Scholarship, you must meet all the following criteria:

1. You must be of African American / Black decent.
2. Active in community service, church, civic organization, etc.,
- 3. You must be a student in East Contra Costa County public schools or a resident of East County attending school in the Mt. Diablo School District (Central County).**
4. You must have a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher.
5. You must be a high school senior who has been accepted for admission within one year of the scholarship award as a full-time student in a community college, four-year accredited institution, or vocational school.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES & CHECKLIST

Please note: Failure to fully complete and return the application and additional materials by **Friday, June 19, 2020** could result in disqualification.

- You must complete the entire application.
- You must have **TWO** references from a teacher or administrator.
- You must have an official copy of your transcript and it needs to be included with your application.
- You must submit a **ONE PAGE, DOUBLE-SPACED** personal statement that explains and highlights the following areas/topics:
 - Background on who you are and sets you apart
 - Why you have a desire to attend college
 - How will your college education benefit you?
 - Why you should be selected as a scholarship recipient

Please note: Personal Statements over the page limit may not be considered.

- Please attach a **2x2** picture (wallet size) of yourself to your essay. Head shot only (e.g. graduation picture, school picture, etc.). **NO** full body shots (e.g., prom pictures, sports photos, newspaper articles, etc.) and **DO NOT** staple picture.
- If you are accepted as a recipient you must show proof of acceptance to an institution of higher learning; (community college, four-year accredited institution or vocational school) within one year of the scholarship award along with the *complete* address and telephone number of the Financial Aid Office. **If you are chosen, you will be notified by letter with the specific time and date for an interview with the Scholarship Committee.**

Note: We strongly suggest that as soon as you receive this application request your transcript from the school and letters of recommendation from your teachers in order to have all the required information before submission.
