

Thank you for your interest in our Apprenticeship Programs!

We generally only accept applications once a year for our programs. This is usually done in early February (For 2019, Feb 4-8, 8am-12noon). Show up in person, 935 Detroit Ave., Concord CA 94518.

This all starts with the application process. Once you have applied, you will get a test time, and test date. **(Minimum requirements at the time of application, High School Diploma/GED, and some form of Government issued photo I.D, driver's license/passport).** Test consist of High School Math, and Mechanical Reasoning problems. If you pass the test with combined average score of 75% or better you will move on to the next step. Oral interview will be the next step. After your oral interview your test scores will be combined with your interview score. A ranked list will be created to go to work, and start in one of our training programs. This is not a fast process, it takes a while, but this insures we get the best candidates into our programs, for a lasting career!

Once you are accepted into the program, there is no cost for the training! At this time starting wage for 1<sup>st</sup> Period Apprentice is \$25.04 an hour w/benefits, with a raise every 6 months, (provided you work steady, and pass all your classes). All the way up to 10<sup>th</sup> Period Apprentice at \$52.15 an hour. This is a 5 year Skilled Craft Apprenticeship, and when you turn out as a Journeyman your rate will be \$61.35 an hour in pay, and the fringe package paid by your contractor for every hour you work is \$42.75.

If you work 50 weeks out of a year at \$61.35 an hour that's \$122,700.00 a year with no student loans to pay off, and full benefits on top of that!!!!
