- *Yearlong classes are YEAR LONG!* No dropping at or during the semester.
- *VAPA*-If planning to be A-G eligible
- *AP courses*- talk to teachers, summer homework
- Repeating core if failed

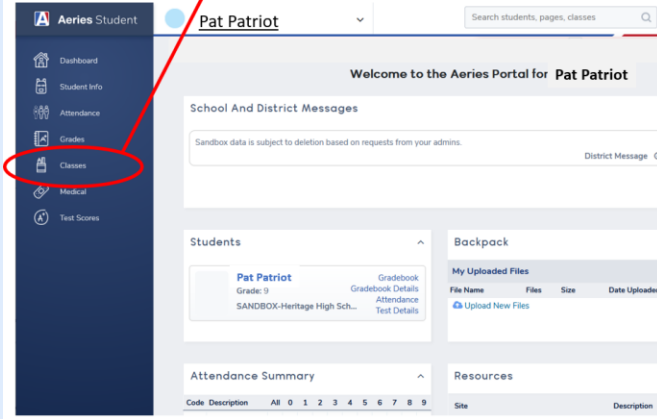

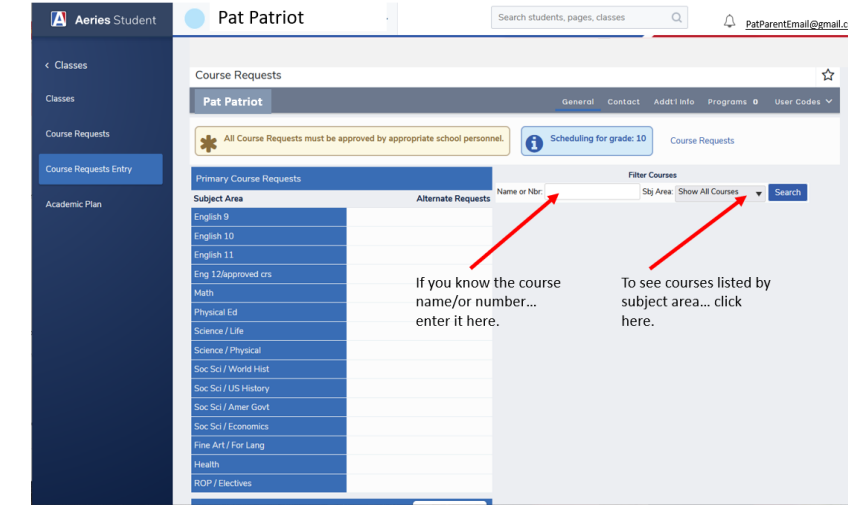
Online Course Request Instructions

2. Click on the 'Classes' Menu



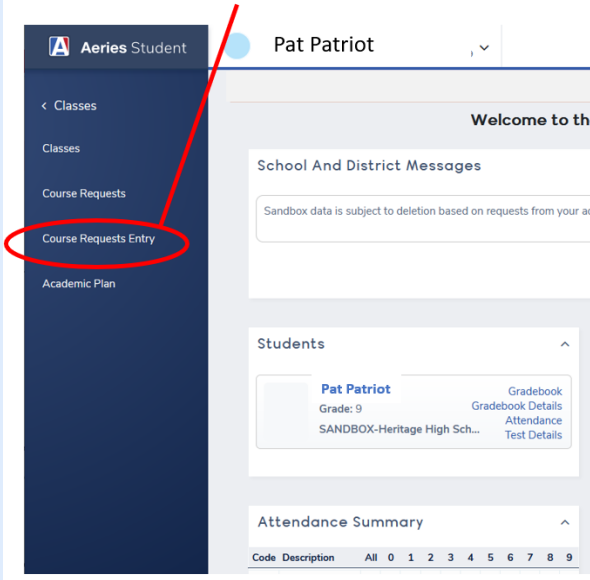
Step 1: Log into Aeries and click on Classes

On the Course Requests Entry page you will be able to enter all of the courses you want to take next year ... just as if you are writing them on your Course Request Form!

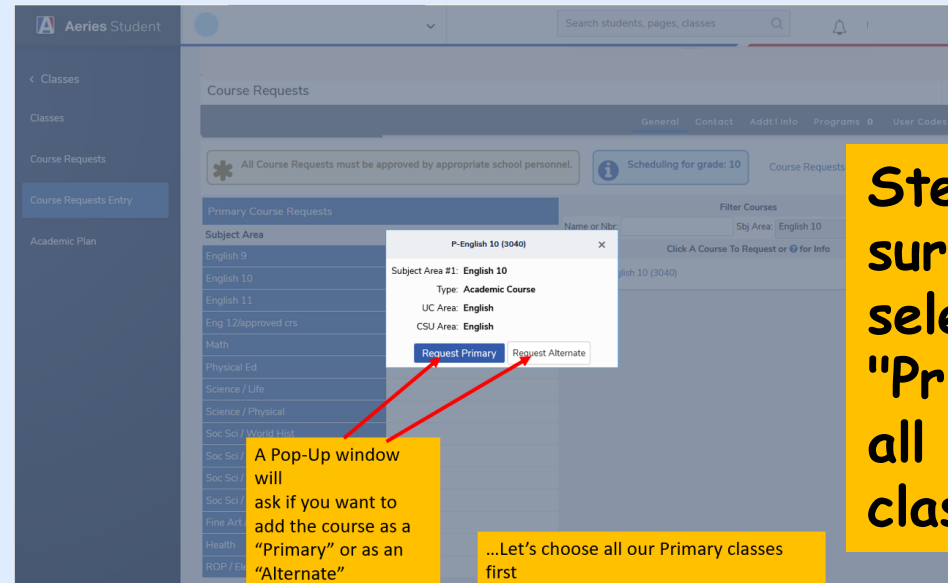


Step 3: Type in your classes in the search and select the course you want

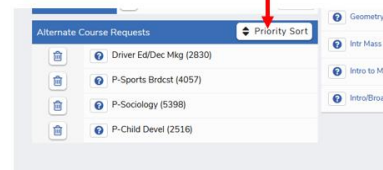
Repeat that process for all of your Elective classes...
