WHO: Presently enrolled (2019-20) 9th, 10th, 11th 12th grade LUHSD students. Applications are processed in the order

received and prioritized by grade level (12, 11, 10, 9).

WHY: To provide opportunities for students to remediate FAILED courses or improve "D" grades (if space available).

WHAT: Courses required for graduation (a-g but **not** NCAA).

All Courses will be offered through Edgenuity (classroom + online). *Specific details on page 2

WHEN: SESSION 1: June 10 – June 19 SESSION 2: June 22 – July 1

Times TBD by the Summer School Office: Either 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. or 12:00 noon – 3:00 p.m. (3 hours/day).

Session placement based on the semester course needed (e.g. If Geometry Semester 2 is needed then Summer School Session 2 will be scheduled. *Exception – if student needs two courses (same semester).

APPLICATION DEADLINE: SESSION 1 (sem 1 course) – By Friday, March 13 SESSION 2 (sem 2 course) – ASAP

LOCATION: Heritage High School – 101 American Avenue, Brentwood, CA 94513

ATTENDANCE: Mandatory – More than 6 hours missed for any reason may result in dismissal from the program.

FOOD SERVICES: Breakfast and lunch will be available and free/reduced provided for eligible students. Summer School is a

CLOSED CAMPUS; students may not leave campus during breaks or lunch. Please do not deliver food to

students.

TRANSPORTATION: LUHSD shuttle service (bus) will be available for those students attending Summer School. Students will be

transported to/from HHS from/to the front of LHS and corner of Neroly and Brown Rd. for FHS (not home).

EDGENUITY LAB Courses Offered: Math, English, Social Science, Science, Health, Strategies for Academic Success (elective)

The curriculum offered in Summer School adheres to the school board-mandated Liberty Union High School District 9th-12th grade courses of study. We will be utilizing a blended learning opportunity in all courses in hopes to best serve students in need of credit recovery and grade improvement.

<u>Summer Edgenuity (Summer Edge) Program, Features and Information:</u>

- The courses use audio (headphones provided), video and text content and different types of assignments including writing assignments, projects and graded tasks to support different learning styles.
- Common Core Standards-aligned online video-based curriculum in a blended learning environment with teacher support in a mandatory 3 hour a day class.
- The program allows educators to customize the curriculum for their students, including modifying or accommodating the needs of students with IEP's and/or 504 Plans.
- Students access the curriculum via the internet through a computer in class (home, city library, etc.) or tablet and begin the program with an orientation and followed by lecture-style lessons.
- Student and parent must read, sign and return the Academic Integrity Policy with the application (backside of application)
- Showing mastery in the pre-test process will eliminate specific activities and the course will be automatically adjusted (less time needed to complete the course). * Exception: No pre-test process for Grade Improvement courses.
- Teachers motivate, guide and monitor student progress as the student moves through course requirements completing
 lessons, assessments, and interactive activities, including virtual labs in science. A student typically works online for 30
 hours (to complete a 5-credit course).
- While in class, students are required to work on lessons the entire period (a scheduled break will take place).
- *Student may complete the course before the session end date by passing the mandatory assignments and hours online during and after school hours; the more hours put in, the faster Summer School may be over. Once the teacher verifies that the student has completed a course, they are no longer required to attend class. This will be communicated to both student and parent (do not assume).
- Students must leave campus immediately following their scheduled class (no loitering) due to another group of students entering the classroom. If taking the shuttle, students MUST take the shuttle that correlates with their class schedule and cannot ride early or return late.
- Lack of significant progress, more than 6 hours of absences or inability to follow rules may result in the student being "inactivated" and **dropped from Summer School**.

With this model, **Motivation is the key!** Please do everything in your power to make sure your student works on Edgenuity while away from school.

I AM AWARE THAT:

- Teachers will support, guide and monitor my progress as I move independently through course requirements.

- I must complete all required coursework by the target date. If not, I will need to conference with the teacher.

I AM COMMITTED TO:

- Turning off (disabling) and putting away my cell phone and/or unauthorized devices during class.
- Actively participating in the online education program.
- Logging on and working at least 3 hours per week outside of my scheduled class/lab time and keeping up with my targeted completion percentage.
- Setting a goal for overall achievement of 70% or higher, and passing all tests with a 60% or higher.
- Communicating with the teacher regarding any challenges I have with the assignments or the program.
- Abiding by the district technology acceptable use requirements.
