

Spanish 2 Assignment for the week of 4/6-4/10

Objective:

- Vocabulary Learning Chapter 5A: (Includes vocabulary about natural disasters, weather extremes, fires, rescues, and the news.)
- Use the review vocabulary on page 236 to review and make sure that you remember words that will help you with this unit.
- Review Spanish phrases using tener on page 237.

Materials needed:

- Workbook: Guided Practice pages 161, 162, and Core pages 5A-B, 5A-1, and 5A-2. (These are available as a PDF on my webpage.)

Instructions:

1. Use Quizlet daily to practice the vocabulary. (At least 10 minutes per day is recommended). You may also use your flashcards.
 - First review the review words from page 236. Study the Set on Quizlet titled: "Realidades 2, Capitulo 5A, Repaso" to

make sure that you remember the words that we should know before we begin the new words for Chapter 5A.

- Next, learn the new vocabulary from Chapter 5A pg 262.

Use the Quizlet set titled: "Realidades 2, Capitulo 5A"

2. Complete the workbook pages above in the same manner that we have done homework in the past. ***The work should be in your own handwriting like you have always done. No typed work will be accepted.*** I will be assigning the same scores as customary. (2,3,4 etc.) Remember that the workbook pages are meant to be practice. Keep the learning objective in mind and make sure that you are practicing the vocabulary while you are completing the workbook pages.
