It is a warning illustrating the unintentional consequences of uncontrolled & reckless growth and how it can unleash such destruction. An industry can create its own market and/or the need for its own product; a fad can develop for unneeded and useless items (remember Rainbow Loom and Fidget Spinners). Unregulated destruction of resources can occur when profits are involved. Yet hope is given at the end that even near total destruction of a species or an ecosystem may be reversed with dedication, hard work and diligence.
