

A course for <u>beginning</u> design students, Design 1 is a prerequisite for the Fine Arts and Digital Arts Pathways in the Engineering Technology Academy. Students will explore various design fields through a variety of projects, while learning to manipulate the elements and principles of design to create fresh, bold approaches to various design issues. Graphics, fashion, interior and product design problems will be investigated.

Expectations for Students

Students are expected to be on time to class and in their seats when the bell rings. Attendance is extremely important. These projects are difficult to make up at home without direction from the teacher, proper materials and equipment. In the event of an excused absence (sick), students will be allowed 4 days to make up work. Students who have been absent due to suspension or cutting class will have the opportunity to discuss the possibility of make-up work. (I will hear you out.) However, I reserve the right to say no. Students should use class time, wisely. I give adequate time for projects and expect completion by the due date. Please come prepared to work with a positive attitude and a pencil. I will call home if your grade slips to a D or F.

Grading

Student grades will be based on their completion of assigned projects, test scores, written assignments and participation. Specific criteria for each assignment can be found on the rubrics used to assess student work. Letter grades are derived from the following percentages:
