1. Go to the Clever homepage <https://clever.com/>
2. Click the "Log in as a student" in the top-right corner
3. Type in "Heritage High School" to find your school
(Make sure you choose the one that says Liberty Union High School District, CA)
4. Your **username** and **password** are both your ***Student ID #***.
5. You are all set! Any time you set a textbook assignment written on today's agenda in class, you can now log in and complete it online!

Clever Assignment Quick Help

Here are some steps to find your assignments on CLEVER.

- Math assignments show up under your "Math-Big Ideas" section. Be sure to click on math.
- Next, ignore all the fancy colorful boxes and click the "assignments" tab in the top-middle of the page.



- Choose an assignment to work on from the list. Click the pencil/enter to start the assignment.
- CLEVER does NOT automatically save and submit progress. Once you finish the last problem in an assignment, be sure to click your name in the top-right corner and click "SAVE" and then "Submit" to turn your assignment in.
