Weekly Assignments:

Assignments will be posted on my website every Monday at 9 am. The assignment is due the following Monday at 12 pm. Assignments can be submitted using Clever, email, or a paper copy can be turned into the main office. (Important: First AND Last name, Mrs. Dodson, Course, and period number must be stated on all assignments.) The first few weeks of Distance Learning we will review Circles to allow other classes to catch up. This will be a nice way to adjust to this dynamic.

Video Tutorials:

In order to give instruction, I will use Zoom and my email. The live Zoom tutorials schedule can be found on my website. (See Zooming through COVID-19). The live classroom norms are attached to this letter and to my website. All live tutorials will be recorded and posted to my website for students unable to attend live.) If students have questions outside of the Zoom meeting time, please email me. I can answer your questions via email or arrange a Zoom meeting. Students are not required to participate in a Zoom meeting.

Policy Changes:

If students have assignments missing from Quarter 3, please email me to arrange how to make up the work. Quarter 4 assignments must be turned in within the week they are assigned. No late work will be permitted. I will reach out to students towards the end of each week, if I have not seen activity on Clever, received an email, or paper copy not found in my on-campus inbox.

Clever Instructions:

The preferred method of submitting assignments is using Clever. The instructions are attached to this letter and on my website.

Zoom Tutorials:

Zoom meeting dates are posted on my website. Students are not required to participate in a live tutorial. Zoom meetings will be used to give some basic instructions. Zoom meeting will have many restrictions to guarantee the tutorial is productive. Students will be placed in a Waiting Room and allowed into the Meeting Room if their full name is visible, muted, and background is permissible.
