Graduation is approaching fast.....

For those students who are unsure of their graduation status or are in jeopardy of not graduating, it is imperative that you immediately meet with our counselor, Ms. Abono. Either make an appointment through her counseling tile on Canvas or stop in when you are on campus.

Please be reminded that to participate in the graduation commencement, students must meet all graduation requirements (required credits) before June 3rd, 2025.

We expect that all graduates return **all textbooks and/or district technology devices such as a laptop** before a diploma is issued (preferably before graduation day). Students who have outstanding books or technology equipment will be notified.

Graduation Commencement Details and Important Dates:

When: Tuesday, June 3rd

Where: Liberty High School Ghiggeri Gymnasium

Parking: LHS student and staff lots and City parking structure on 2nd St. also available

Time: Doors open at 5:00 p.m. and the commencement ceremony begins promptly at 6:00pm

IMPORTANT ------ Graduates must arrive to the staging area (small gym) by 5:15 p.m. We will also be taking a class picture at 5:30pm. Graduates will then be directed to meet with their Primary Teacher, receive their announcement name card and review walking instructions.

Beginning Monday, May 19: Graduates may begin the process of picking up graduation items.

- Caps with basic 2025 tassels and gowns will be available in the office at no cost. Additional basic tassels are \$10; we accept cash or checks made out to IHS (limited quantities)
- Graduation tickets are required for all guests attending the graduation ceremony. No exceptions. Each graduate may request and receive up to 10 tickets on the day they pick up their cap/tassel/gown. Please only request what you need because others may need additional.

Additional Information

- A photographer will take a class picture at 5:30 pm and individual pictures of students as they receive their diplomas. If you are interested in purchasing photos, information will be available when you receive your cap/tassel and gown. Graduates must dress appropriately (no shorts, flip-flops, or bare feet). Decorated caps must be acceptable (positive and approved by staff at the staging area).
- **Our school will not have a graduation walk-through practice;** more information on this will be given to students in May.
