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

OFFICIAL SUMMER SCHOOL 2024 APPLICATION PACKET

(NOT INTENDED FOR ESY LIFE SKILLS PURPOSES – PLEASE SEE YOUR STUDENTS CASE MANAGER)

Summer School is an opportunity (not mandatory) for all LUHSD students to remediate required FAILED courses for graduation and/or improve "D" grades for a-g purposes (if space is available). *Please note: Courses are **not** NCAA-eligible

WHEN: June 11 – July 3 (*No School July 19 - Holiday*)

 **Times TBD by the Summer School Office:** Either 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. or 12:00 noon – 3:00 p.m. (3 hours/day).

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SPRING SEMESTER 2024 WALK-IN REGISTRATION

Applications will be accepted IN-PERSON ONLY (parent and student must be present)

ATTENDANCE: **In-person attendance is mandatory.** Because summer courses cover extensive instructional content in a relatively short time period, consistent attendance is crucial. **Students who have more than one absence and/or have not completed the entire course may not receive credit for summer session class(es).** - Board Policy / AR 6177

FOOD SERVICES: Lunch will be available for all students. Summer School is a **CLOSED CAMPUS**; students may not leave campus during breaks or lunch. **Please do not deliver food to students.**

TRANSPORTATION: LUHSD bus will be available for students attending Summer School. Students will be transported to/from FHS from/to LHS Oak St. parking lot and the front of HHS (American Ave. city bus stop).

Please refer to the times below as it correlates with the student's class schedule:

11:15am (PM classes)

Departure from FHS to HHS/LHS

11:45am (AM classes)

3:10pm (PM classes)


Students **MUST** take the bus that correlates with their class schedule and cannot ride early or return late.

PROCEDURES: Parents and Students –

- Carefully review information for accuracy, communicate with counselor and sign pages 3 and 4.
- Submit application to your counselor **on or before** the deadline (***Exception: Spring Semester 2024**).
- Keep pages 1 and 2 for your reference.

The curriculum offered in all Summer School programs adheres to the school board-mandated LUHSD 9-12th grade courses of study and courses are offered through Imagine Edgenuity (Edgenuity) – Math, English, Social Science, Science, Health

Features and Information:

- Common Core Standards-aligned online video-based curriculum in a blended learning environment (school **and** home).
- The program allows educators to customize the curriculum for their students, including modifying or accommodating the needs of students with IEP's and/or 504 Plans.
- Teachers motivate, guide, support and monitor student progress as the student moves through course requirements completing lessons, assessments, and interactive activities, including virtual labs in science. **In order to complete a credit recovery course (previously failed 5 credit course), a student typically works online for 30 hours.**
- Students may only take one course at a time, and a total of two during the summer program.
- **ATTENDANCE POLICY** – In-person attendance is mandatory. **Because summer courses cover extensive instructional content in a relatively short time period, consistent attendance is crucial.** Students who have more than one absence and/or have not completed the entire course may not receive credit for summer session class(es). - **Board Policy / AR 6177**
- With this model, motivation is the key! **Students are required to actively participate and produce a minimum of 10% daily progress** while doing their very best to pass all activities including quizzes/tests. This includes additional online work produced while at home.
- **In order to earn credit, students must complete 100% of the course (including pre-tests).**
- Students earn the “Overall Grade” of the course.
- Showing mastery in the pre-test process will eliminate specific activities and the course will be automatically adjusted (less time needed to complete the course).
- Student may complete the course before the session end date by meeting the required course criteria (see teacher). **The faster progress is made, the quicker the course may be completed.** Course completion will be communicated to both the student and parent (do not assume).
- Students will access the curriculum via Clever.com / Imagine Edgenuity and **NOT** Canvas. The course begins with an orientation and is followed by video-based instruction. Summer School will provide **in-person** computers/laptops (not take-home devices). If your student has a district-loaned laptop from his/her home site, he/she may choose to bring that device instead.
- Each course uses video and text content and various types of assignments including writing assignments, projects and graded tasks to support different learning styles.
- Each course also uses audio, in which we will provide **in-person** headphones that must be returned daily. Your student may elect to bring their own, but they must be compatible 3.5mm AUX audio cables pictured here. 
- While in class, students are required to work on lessons the entire period (a scheduled in-class break will take place).
- All students must leave campus immediately following their scheduled class (no loitering). If a school bus is available, students **MUST** take the bus that correlates with their class schedule and may not ride early or return late.
- Student and parent must read, **sign, and return the Academic Integrity Policy (AIP)** with the application (Page 4 - backside of the application)

I AM AWARE THAT:

- I may only take one Imagine Edgenuity (IE) course at a time.
- In-person class attendance is mandatory.
- Teachers will support, guide, and monitor my progress as I move independently through course requirements.
- The pretesting option will be enabled and discussed by the teacher.
- I will be required to take notes for each lesson for quizzes and tests. This can be via eNotes or a traditional notebook. If I do not take notes, I may be required to redo the direct instruction lecture.
- I will be given 3 attempts to pass each test. If I do not pass after 3 attempts, I will have to conference with the teacher to either earn another attempt or an alternative assessment.
- If there is a concern with possible cheating at any time, assessments may be administered in person only.
- **I must complete 100% of all required coursework by the target date.** If not, a no mark (NM) will be issued.

I AM COMMITTED TO:

- Turning off (disabling) and putting away my cell phone and/or unauthorized devices while in IE.
- Actively participating and producing a minimum of 10% daily progress along with passing all assignments, quizzes, and tests (60% or higher, 70% or higher for grade improvement courses).
- Logging on and productively working additional hours outside of my scheduled in-class time.
- Communicating with the teacher regarding any challenges I have with the assignments or the program.
- Abiding by the district technology acceptable use requirements.

I PLEDGE THAT I WILL **NOT**:

- Plagiarize or cheat, including allowing others to do my online work.
- Use websites that provide answers to assignments or assessments.
- Give unauthorized assistance on assessments, or allow others to give me assistance on assessments.
- Have additional sites (windows open) on the computer/laptop other than IE-approved sites.
- Use or access any outside resources (including cell phone) during assessments.
- Post assessments, assignments, answers to assessments or assignments, or any other curricular materials on any media that could be viewed by other students or other third parties.
