Definition:

Under the direction of the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum, Instruction, and Research, the New Teacher Coach is responsible for on-going support of the district's first and second year teachers as described in the Liberty Union High School District New Teacher Support Program.

Examples of Duties:

- •Meet regularly with assigned first and second year teachers to provide support and assessment as determined by the Liberty Union High School District New Teacher Support Program
- •Participate in all first and second year New Teacher Support Program activities
- •Observe new teachers in the classroom and provide constructive professional feedback and support
- •Complete New Teacher Support Training and New Teacher Assessment Training
- •Monitor new teacher's completion of Performance Area Expectations and activities using project assessment instruments
- •Participate in regular new teacher coach meetings
- •Communicate regularly with New Teacher Mentor and administration on issues related to the program
- •Participate in annual evaluation of New Teacher Support Program
