Payment Schedule and Discounts

A **10% discount** on a **Round-Trip Annual Pass only** will be given if purchased **by July 27, 2021**. Payment **must** be received before a student rides the bus.

A family will receive a discount for multiple riders on annual, semi-annual, and quarterly school year round trip passes only.

Refunds

Refunds are available if your child experiences a medical illness which exceeds 15 consecutive days and is accompanied by a physician's statement. Should you move out of district permanently and your child is to attend another district you may apply for a refund. **If a child is removed from the bus for discipline reasons, there will be no refund.**

Requests for refund must be made by you in writing and must also include the pass.

Pupils transported in a school bus shall be under the authority of, and responsible to, the driver of the bus. The state law gives the school bus driver full responsibility for the safety and conduct of students on the school bus. Those laws also state that students riding the bus are to refrain from disorderly conduct which may distract the driver and endanger the safety of all. Infractions of bus rules and regulations may result in the denial of transportation. These rules and regulations have been distributed to all students and their parent(s)/guardian(s). (Refer to Title 5, Code of Regulations section 14103.)

For each occurrence of unsatisfactory conduct, an incident report will be filled out. The consequences of this conduct will be determined by the school administrator. When a pupil is denied bus transportation, it is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s) to provide transportation to and from school. Also, if the behavior is considered to be detrimental to the safety and welfare of the passengers on the bus, the immediate removal of the student will be at the discretion of the Director of Transportation with immediate notification to parent(s)/guardian(s).

BUS RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Obey the authority of the bus driver.
2. Be at the bus stop 10 minutes before pick-up time.
3. Remain seated.
4. If bus is equipped with seat belts, belt must be worn at all times.
5. Keep hands and head inside the bus at all times.
6. Be courteous to others. No inappropriate language.
7. Students are to remain quiet at railroad crossings.
8. No glass, hazardous material, skateboards, roller blades, weapons, radios, laser pointers or balls allowed on the bus.
9. No animals, reptiles or insects allowed on the bus.
10. Do not destroy property; Parent/Guardian will be held financially responsible.
11. Students will be escorted by driver only.
12. Student's behavior is to be orderly before, during and after bus arrival.
13. No eating, drinking, gum or smoking on the bus.
14. No loud distracting noises.
15. Bus pass must be presented to driver upon request.
16. Bus pass may not be used by any other student.
17. Students must use assigned bus stop.
18. Students must NOT approach bus after it leaves stop.
