Residency Verification: Incoming 8th graders will have the opportunity to come in and verify residency during July **prior** to walk thru. Please DO NOT attach any proof of residency at this time. Only complete the residency declaration. More information regarding walk thru including dates and times will be sent out toward the end of the 2021 - 2022 school year. If you do not complete residency verification for the 2022 - 2023 school year prior to walk thru, it must be completed at walk thru. This includes physical documents to be photo copied at walk thru. No visual or electronic verification will be accepted.

If you have applied for an intra-district transfer to another school in the district, you must enroll at your <u>current home school</u> until the intra-district has been approved. Please do not fill out paperwork for both schools. Enrollment should only be completed for the home school.
