Students are eligible to apply if they are:

- A U.S. Citizen
- A permanent resident
- An eligible non-citizen
- A T-Visa holder

CADAA

Students are eligible to apply if they:

- Are undocumented
- Have a valid or expired DACA
- Are a U-Visa holder
- Have Temporary Protected Status (TPS)
- Meet the non-resident exemption requirements under AB 540

FAFSA STUDENTS

Students will need:

- Access to their IRS 1040 (and their parents if they are a dependent student) for two years prior to the application year if you worked.
- Their Social Security Number (SSN), Green Card (I-551, I-151, or I-551C), I-94, Battered immigrant status, or T-visa.
- Their parents' Social Security numbers (if a dependent student). If the parent does not have an SSN or has an I-TIN, put zeros in its place.
- Student's Drivers License if they have one.

Important application steps:

- 1. Create an FSA ID online.
 - a. A parent of a dependent student will create their own FSA ID.
- 2. Follow the steps onscreen and answer the questions.
- 3. Sign the form using your FSA ID.
 - a. Parents use their FSA ID to submit their electronic signatures.

CADAA STUDENTS

- Access to their IRS 1040 for two years prior to the application year if you worked.
- Access their parents' IRS 1040 for two years prior to the application year (if dependent).
- To have or create a parent PIN (if dependent).

- 1. Complete the eligibility screening.
- 2. Follow the steps onscreen and answer the questions.
- 3. If the student or the student's parent does not have an SSN or has an ITIN, use zeros instead.
- 4. Students sign the form using their account login.
 - a. Parents use their Parent Pin to sign electronically.

AFTER SUBMISSION

After a student completes and submits a financial aid application:

- The Department of Education or California Student Aid Commission will send the student a copy of the application, which should be reviewed for accuracy.
- A copy will be sent to Los Medanos College typically within 7-10 business days.

 - Students will receive an email regarding your financial aid status once available.
- Click on the Financial Aid tile in InSite and complete any missing or required documents.
- Once the file is complete:
 - Students will receive an award notification letter.
