

Arbitrators, Mediators, & Conciliators

Also called: Alternative Dispute Resolution Coordinator (ADR Coordinator), Arbitrator, Labor Arbitrator, Mediator

What they do:

Facilitate negotiation and conflict resolution through dialogue. Resolve conflicts outside of the court system by mutual consent of parties involved.

On the job, you would:

- Prepare written opinions or decisions regarding cases.
- · Apply relevant laws, regulations, policies, or precedents to reach conclusions.
- · Conduct hearings to obtain information or evidence relative to disposition of claims.

Orange states have an above average share of this career in their workforce.


Blue states have a **below average** share of this career in their workforce.

Nationwide, new job opportunities for arbitrators, mediators, and conciliators are **very likely** in the future.



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
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

- Workers on average earn \$62,020


