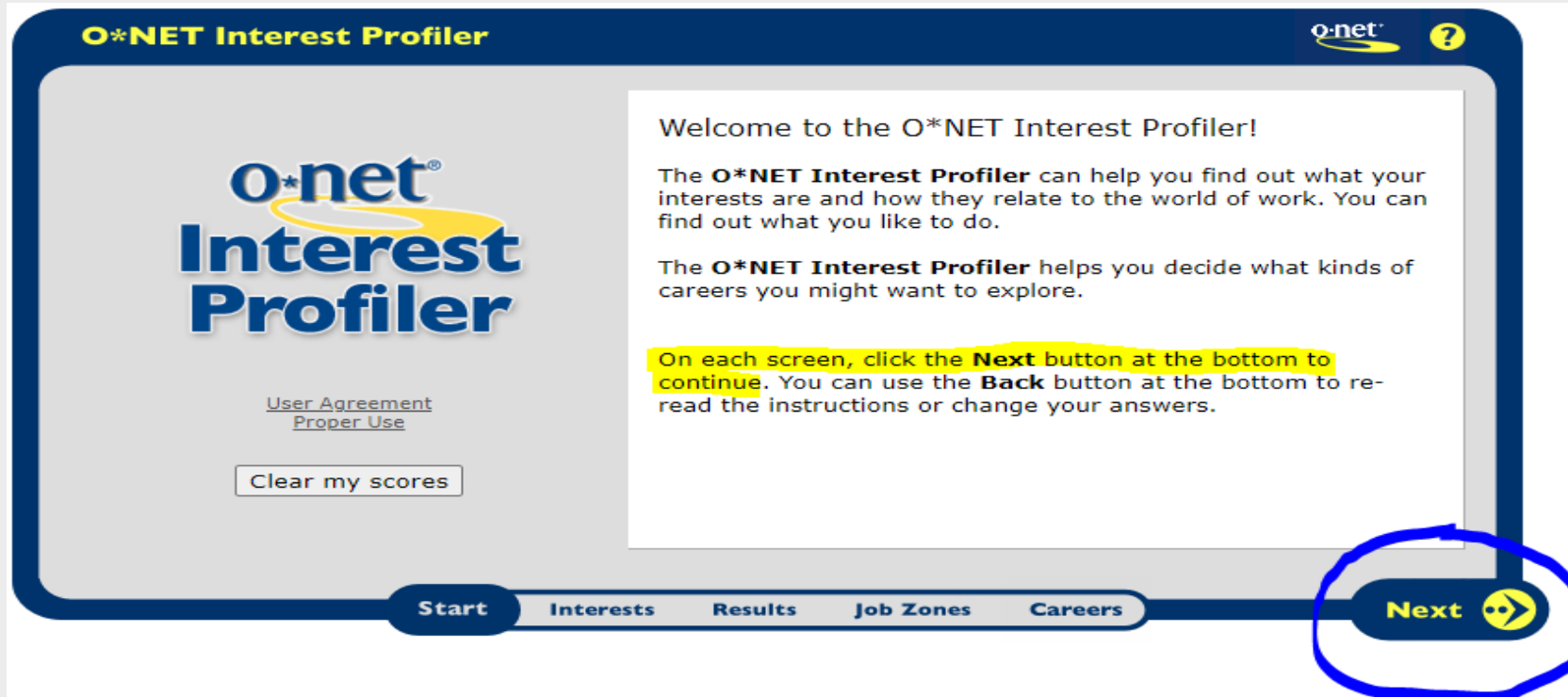

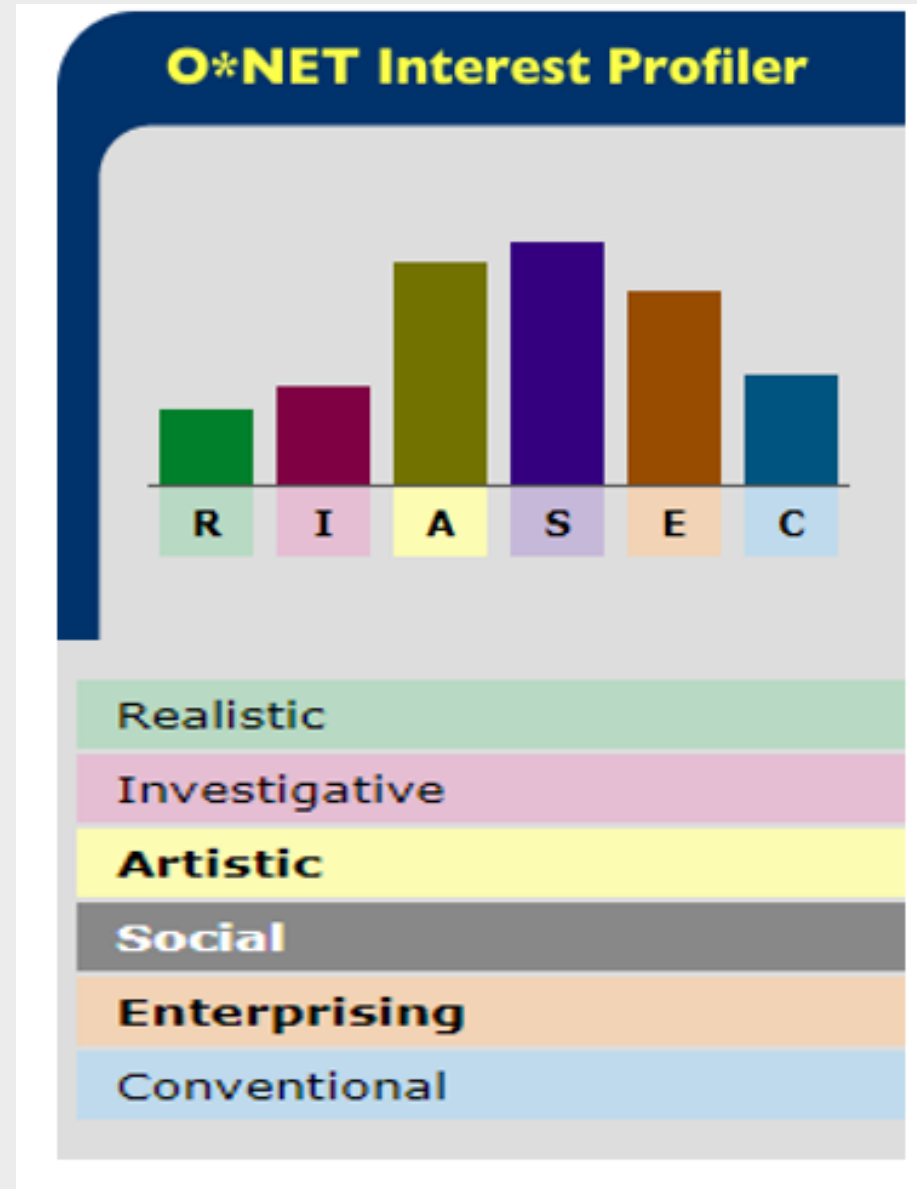

## Arbitrators, Mediators, & Conciliators

**Also called:** Alternative Dispute Resolution Coordinator (ADR Coordinator), Arbitrator, Labor Arbitrator, Mediator

### What they do:

Facilitate negotiation and conflict resolution through dialogue. Resolve conflicts outside of the court system by mutual consent of parties involved.

### On the job, you would:

- Prepare written opinions or decisions regarding cases.
- Apply relevant laws, regulations, policies, or precedents to reach conclusions.
- Conduct hearings to obtain information or evidence relative to disposition of claims.

**Orange** states have an **above average** share of this career in their workforce.

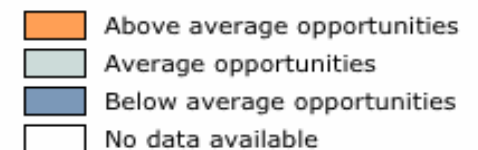
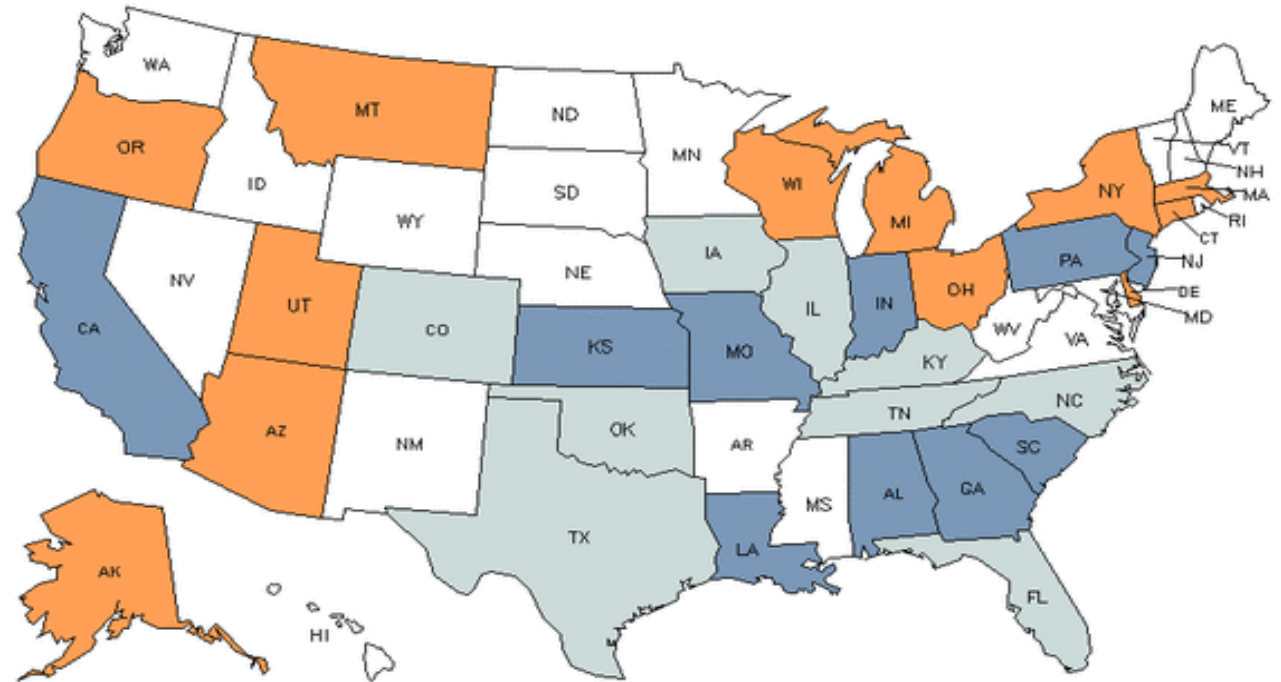
**Blue** states have a **below average** share of this career in their workforce.

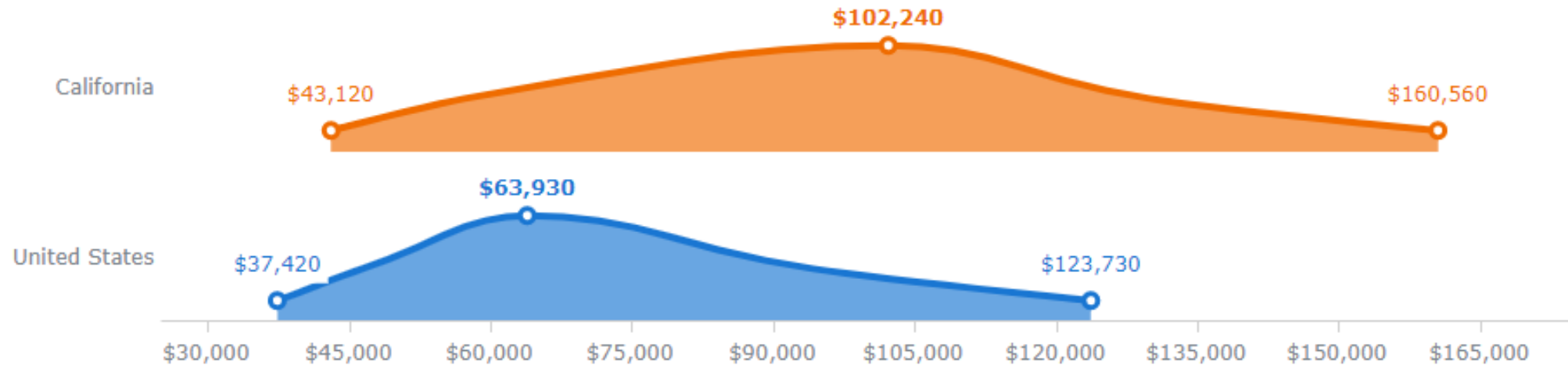
