- Review & Approval of Minutes from 04-13-21 (Dorr/Hovis).
- Review of PPE Request and Distribution process.
 - o All PPE request are made through the VP of Facilities at each site through the work order system
 - Al receives all PPE request work orders
 - Al gathers all necessary PPE supplies per work orders from PPE stock at M & O
 - Al assigns PPE work orders to the day custodial shift from work orders requested and delivers all PPE supplies to custodian to deliver to end users
 - All PPE work orders are closed when PPE supplies have been delivered by custodial staff
 - All delivered PPE supplies are logged in by Regina Hunt at the District in an effort to keep track of supplies from entire PPE inventory
 - All PPE work orders are closed as completed after supplies have been tracked
 - Informed committee members there will be a distribution of cloth reusable mask to each site 2 per staff member and 2 per student

-Site check in regarding PPE and updates on their sites with students on campuses

- CEC- had no representation
- LPHS- Hovis reports- all is well and PPE are adequate
- LHS-Vega reports all is well ad PPE are adequate however will probably need to increase if we go back to full in person school
- FHS-Feldermann reports- as a food service employee PPE has been quick and adequate with no issues. Cannot speak for the school site- no representative from site
- HHS-Johnson & Lynch-Site is functioning well with students and PPE supplies are received quickly and adequate amount but anticipate increases in supplies if we go back to in person learning
- Transportation-McElhaney-PPE supplies are adequate and all is well
- Lizet was not present but sent in the questions below and the responses were provided by Tony Shah who was not present but responded to the questions from Admin.

- Lizet Questions
- It's hard to come up with concerns when we don't know what the CDC guidelines will be by then or where we will be with COVID cases. Here are three questions assuming we stay in the yellow:

- 1. Will everyone still be required to wear masks?
- The mask mandate order was initiated [on November 16th](#) and is separated from the Blueprint for a Safer Economy colored tier system. So regardless of the color our county falls under, all students and employees are mandated to wear masks unless they are medically exempt. At this point, we have no idea when the mask mandate will be lifted. We are predicting it will not be lifted as early as the upcoming fall semester.

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- 2. Will we continue to be provided hand sanitizer, cleaning sanitizer and masks upon our return?
- Yes, we have secured COVID related funding to re-supply our PPE for the upcoming year (including the items in your question).
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- 3. Our classroom are not one size fits all. Therefore, if the 3ft. requirement is still in effect in August, what will be the plan to fit 30-35 students in each classroom? How will this be handled?
- As of right now, we do not know what the physical distancing requirements will be for the upcoming fall semester. Once we have confirmed updates, Mr. Volta, your principal, or another administrator will provide you the relevant updates.
