- CCCSIG Report
 - o Employee injuries are down.
 - Occupation groups-IA's, Teachers and custodial.
 - IA/Teacher=Student Behavior
 - Custodial- remains Slip, Trip and Fall
 - o Active Sites

- LHS and FHS
 - Improvements as shown through the work order system less occurrences
 - Maintenance corrections on paths, slip areas, visibility with painting
 - Majority of occurrences happened in Aug & Sept
 - Training helped-Para's yearly, two per year for SPED but a lot of turnover
 - Causes- wrong type of shoes, student behavior-biting, fighting
- X-MOD
 - Has reduced which shows sign it is getting better
 - 134% last year, 108% this year
- Incentive Program
 - Has 100% completion
- Ladders
 - Purchase process
 - How do sites get new ladders
 - Can safety funds be used to purchase ladders
 - District will look into getting some ladders
