# Intensified Geometry 1

Students will strengthen previous Math skills and apply Critically Thinking to learning Geometry. Students will memorize information and learn when to apply this knowledge to solve problem. Students will learn how to use Deductive and Inductive reasoning; skills they can use in the future.

# Warning: Math class....but more like a language class

Geometry is a math class, but it is NOT LIKE ANY OTHER MATH CLASS TAKEN so far. Students will learn new vocabulary ... apply their rules/formulas/characteristics ... and then solve. CRITICAL THINKING is a very hard skill to learn and it will be difficult for 9 out of 10 students. It is very common for "A/B" Algebra students to struggle with Geometry, and "C/D" students find Geometry much easier. While students with strong Algebra skills will have an easier time with the solving...they have to get through the thinking part first. The faster a student learns the geometry vocabulary, the easier it gets.

### Classroom Expectations:

#### Come with a positive attitude

Be ready to learn
Give everything a try
Ask for help (teacher/buddy/neighbor)

#### Be prepared an on time

Have paper/index cards/ pencils ready and sharpened) every day.

Have your colored-pen ready for correcting completed work.

Have your math binder/book/calendar here every day.

Have assignments completed and ready to correct before the bell.

Take care of all personal necessities (make-up, bathrooms) before and after class.

#### No distracting equipment

Bags and purses should be away and not rummaged through
No electronic devices unless cleared in advance by the instructor.
Only items directly need for the subject are permitted.
I will assume that if anything else out (phone/ipods/make-up/
work for another class) are presents for the teacher and must
be obtained back from the office/teacher at the end of the day.

## Homework, Projects, Quizzes, and Tests:

- Homework in pencil
  - > Name, date, period number in the upper right-hand corner.
  - > Chapter, Section, and problem #s on the top center line.
  - > Peer-corrected with colored pen against the answer key.
  - > Should be turned in the next day.

#### Chapter TEST

- > Basic scientific calculator allowed
- > Worth 100 points
- > 10 extra credit points for not using prepared notes
- Missed Tests are the responsibility of the student and to be arranged to be done outside of class time... with teacher before the next class day.
- ➤ Tests may be corrected and earn back 30% of points missed. (for students not missing any Chapter assignment)

## Math Notebook

Divide into clearly marked...

- 1) Calendars
- 2) Warm-ups
- 3) Homework
- 4) Notes

Bring to class every day, and add to it daily.

Students are expected to keep all work with them.

Keep work in order (most current in front)

Collected at the end of each chapter for points (based on neatness, organization, and completeness.)

While I respect the privacy of your work and ideas, remember that if I read something in your notebook that I will endangers you or someone else, I must report it.

#### Attendance:

There is no substitution to the immediate help and guidance a student receives in class. Students are highly encouraged to come in to turn in HW and find out what they missed. In case an absence is unavoidable, use the monthly calendar and posted notes to stay caught up. Students have one day to make-up missed work.

## 3x5 index cards

These are <u>key to learning</u>. Students need to bring these to class as well as blank ones. These will be filled out every day in class for the current day's lesson. I strongly suggest getting a heady duty ring, flip binder, rubber band, or sturdy Ziploc bag for these. The idea is to commit to memory what is on the cards. This one thing a parent can do to help ensure the student can keep up and do well on any exam. I strongly encourage students to review cards 5-10 minutes daily as needed. Every card (a few exceptions) should have 1) the term (on one side), 2) hint words, 3) picture, 4) example/formula.

### o Quizzes in pencil

- > Worth 50 points.
- > Vocab Quizzes may be retaken one-time only

#### Warm-ups in pencil

- > Based on past lesson and any prior lesson
- > Accountable for half of points.
- > Students are allowed to access notes & collaborate with peers.

### o 3x5 index cards

- > Completed and neatly (as shown in class)
- > False/unreadable cards will not count for credit
- > These will be used to quiz or study by yourself or classmates.

#### o Projects

- > Details and Grading Rubric to come for each
- Designed to be done out of class over a period of several weeks.
