

## Liberty Union High School District Isolation & Quarantine Guidance

## Updated 1/15/2022

<ul> <li>Any positive test, regardless of the type of test or vaccination status of the individual</li> <li>Isolate (stay home) for at least 5 days</li> <li>Test on or after Day 5 <ul> <li>If you <u>have</u> symptoms: Day 1 is the day after the symptoms started</li> <li>If you <u>do not have</u> symptoms: Day 1 is the day after the positive test result</li> <li>Antigen test preferred</li> </ul> </li> <li>If test is negative, you may return to school on or after Day 6 if you are fever-free and all other symptoms are improving</li> <li>Wear a well-fitting mask around others at all times, indoors and outdoors, for the entire 10-day period (at work, home, and in the community) <ul> <li>This may impact your participation in extracurricular activities</li> </ul> </li> <li>If on the test or choose not to test, isolation is required for 10 days</li> <li>If positive test is obtained or 10 days of isolation have passed</li> <li>If test negative and fever still present, continue to isolate until no fever for at least 24 hours without medication</li> <li>If test negative and other symptoms are not improving, continue to isolate until symptoms are not improving, continue to isolate until symptoms are resolving</li> </ul>	Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolation Required)	Actions
to return to school	type of test or vaccination status of	<ul> <li>Test on or after Day 5 <ul> <li>If you <u>have</u> symptoms: Day 1 is the day after the symptoms started</li> <li>If you <u>do not have</u> symptoms: Day 1 is the day after the positive test result</li> <li>Antigen test preferred</li> </ul> </li> <li>If test is negative, you may return to school on or after Day 6 if you are fever-free and all other symptoms are improving</li> <li>Wear a well-fitting mask around others at all times, indoors and outdoors, for the entire 10-day period (at work, home, and in the community) <ul> <li>This may impact your participation in extracurricular activities</li> </ul> </li> <li>If unable to test or choose not to test, isolation is required for 10 days</li> <li>If positive test on or after Day 5, stay isolated until a negative test is obtained or 10 days of isolation have passed</li> <li>If test negative and fever still present, continue to isolate until no fever for at least 24 hours without medication</li> <li>If test negative and other symptoms are resolving</li> <li>Test results should be provided to the attendance office</li> </ul>

Group Contact to COVID Positive Individual in School (No Quarantine Required)	Actions
Regardless of vaccination status or previous infection of the individual	<ul> <li>Continue to attend school unless you develop symptoms or test positive for COVID-19</li> <li>Test 3-5 days after the exposure or sooner if symptoms develop (highly recommended)         <ul> <li>Day 1 is the day after the exposure</li> </ul> </li> <li>If symptoms develop at any time, test and stay home         <ul> <li>If you test positive, follow criteria for positive individuals above</li> </ul> </li> <li>Continue to wear a mask indoors in the school and community</li> </ul>

Close Contact to COVID Positive Individual at Home <u>or</u> in the Community	Actions
<ul> <li>Fully vaccinated* OR</li> <li>Previously infected with (laboratory confirmed) SARS- CoV-2 within the last 90 days</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Continue to attend school</li> <li>Test 3-5 days after the exposure (recommended only)         <ul> <li>Day 1 is the day after the exposure</li> </ul> </li> <li>If symptoms develop at any time, test and stay home         <ul> <li>If you test positive, follow criteria for positive individuals above</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Not fully vaccinated (Quarantine Required)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Quarantine (stay home) for at least 5 days</li> <li>Test on or after Day 5         <ul> <li>Day 1 is the day after the exposure</li> </ul> </li> <li>If test is negative, student may return to school on Day 6</li> <li>If unable to test or choose not to test, quarantine is required for 10 days</li> <li>If symptoms develop at any time, test and stay home</li> <li>If student tests positive, follow criteria for positive individuals above</li> <li>Test results should be provided to the attendance office to return to school</li> </ul>

Symptoms of COVID-19 (Isolation Required)	Actions
COVID-19 Symptoms but NOT a Close Contact, regardless of vaccination status or previous infection of the individual	<ul> <li>Isolate (stay home) and Test</li> <li>You may return to school if you are fever-free, symptoms are improving, and:         <ul> <li>Test negative</li> <li>OR</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
(e.g., fever, cough, runny nose, loss of taste or smell, difficulty breathing)	<ul> <li>Have a doctor's note stating COVID has been ruled out (something else other than COVID-19 infection is reason for symptoms)</li> <li>OR</li> </ul>
Symptom Screening per CDC	<ul> <li>Isolate at home for 10 days since symptoms started</li> <li>If test negative and fever still present, continue to isolate until no fever for at least 24 hours without medication</li> <li>If test negative and other symptoms are not improving, continue to isolate until symptoms are resolving</li> <li>If positive test, stay isolated until a negative test is obtained or 10 days of isolation have passed</li> <li>Test results should be provided to the attendance office to return to school</li> </ul>

Any <u>approved test</u> may now be used, including home tests with photo verification. Test results should be provided to the school's attendance office to return to school.
