May, 2009**


This articulation agreement enables students who have successfully completed the ROP/Contra Costa County Office of Education **Careers with Fire Technology** course at **Freedom High School**, and who meet the **Los Medanos College** admission requirements, to receive college credit. Students may apply to the Los Medanos College Admissions Office to receive 3 units of college credit for **Fire Protection Organization**, articulated with the ROP Fire Science course at Freedom High School.

Students should submit their official high school transcript along with a copy of this agreement **within five years of completing the ROP Fire Science course at Freedom High School** to the Admissions Office at Los Medanos College.




