- 1. Welcome- Principle Kelly welcomes all attendees to the 1st School Site Council Meeting. She discussed the purpose of our SSC meeting and instructions on how the meeting runs.
- 2. Introductions- Everyone took turns introducing themselves around the room.
- 3. **Purpose of SSC-** A committee of teachers, parents, students, and school staff that work with the principal to plan for the needs of the school.
- 4. **Bylaws Around Elections Reviewed-** Principal Kelly Read through SSC Bylaws. All attendees voted for a motion to approve bylaws.
- 5. **Roberts Rules of Order-** Principal Kelly reviewed the handout of RRO basics. Refer to handout for "procedure for handling the motion". Motion to vote on RRO example, Woods did the motion, Luna seconded the motion.

- 8. **Driving Questions Reviewed and Voted upon-** Recap on driving questions. Tania motioned to vote on questions. Wilmore 1st, Luna 2nd. 10-0 vote. Approved.
- 9. Single Site Plan for Students Achievement Introduction, Review and Voted upon- Mrs. Nelson presented on the plan for our school. See handout for details (SPSA). 2021-2022 See pg.3 for school goals, expected measureable outcomes. Voted on single site plan. 10-0 Woods 1st and Luna 2nd the motion.
- **10.** Ethnic Studies Discussion and Feedback for LUHSD- Principal Kelly reviews curriculum and handout on Ethnic Studies Model. The attendee's agreed that they did not want to hide from the language/verbiage and wanted to keep CRT in the outline. They felt it should be followed

however by the second option and include a third sentence that reiterated the course focus on systems, policy, institutional issues vs. studying/targeting individual people.
