 - Take the ASVAB! **September 28th @ 8 a.m.** Register in the Career Center.
- Review for the ACT/SAT- Make practice part of your routine, take free practice tests on <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org> and test prep on Khan Academy. *
- **Sign up to take the PSAT/NMSQT October 25th @ 8 a.m.** Register on the school webstore.
- Review the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) Minimum A-G Course Requirements. Students must have a grade of C or better in these A-G Courses, look for posters around campus.
- **Attend the LUHSD College fair October 20th - 6:00-8:00 PM at Freedom High School**
- Plan to visit colleges, and attend informational Career Center events when colleges plan to visit. *Note: some might be virtual tours.*
- If you're planning on playing collegiate athletics register through **NCAA Eligibility Center**.
- Visit the College & Career Center (or the website) for SAT, PSAT, ASVAB practice tests!
- Find a part-time job, volunteer work, or partake in a summer college program. Obtain your work permit in the Career Center.
- Stay updated by listening for the daily announcements, checking the College & Career webpage, checking out your counselors canvas page and following us on social media!

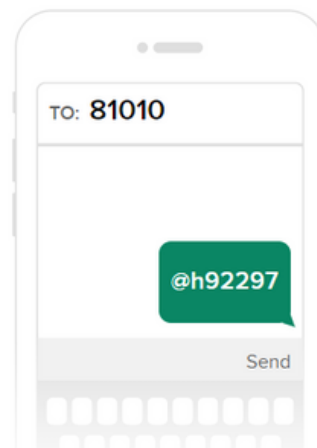
